Over 4,500 students attending Erie Philharmonic Concert

Erie, PA | November 14, 2016

The Erie Philharmonic is honored to present two free concerts on Tuesday, November 15 for over 4,500 students from 51 schools in the region. Students will travel to the Warner Theatre from as far away as Conneautville, Oil City, and Titusville for the program, called “Stormchasers,” featuring a special guest appearance by local weatherman, Tom Atkins from JET-TV. Young violinist soloist Moshi Tang will also perform during the concert.

This 45-minute interactive program offers a musical learning experience for students of all ages. Prior to the concert, each of the 51 schools received a three-unit curriculum that coincides with the topics discussed during the concert. From weather patterns and composer biographies to instrument recognition activities via listening examples, these complimentary materials to help teachers prepare students with complete lesson plans, activities, and data-driven reporting through English, Science, Geography, and Music PA State and Common Core standards.

For the first time in many years, the Erie Philharmonic’s Youth Concert is free for *all* students. This concert is supported by National Fuel, with additional school sponsorships from KnoxLaw, UBS, Cathedral of St. Paul, Erie News Now, Logistics Plus, Rick Griffith Properties, and BKD LLP. Erie County Gaming Revenue Authority also supports this program.
