What To Submit

You may submit either a completed article or an article pitch for consideration.

All article submissions must be at least 500 words in length. We prefer that submissions stay below a 1,000 word count, but understand that some topics are hard to condense.

All article pitches must include a description of the topic to be discussed, the points that will be raised in the article, and any resulting conclusion or advice that will be offered.

Submissions may be in the form of Microsoft Word, Plain Text, Google Docs, or HTML. We do not accept zip files or links for downloading.

General Guidelines

We do not accept articles that have been published elsewhere, whether in whole or in part.

If you are providing your professional opinion about any topic relating to family law, we ask that you provide no less than three citations for your article.

We do not provide any compensation for article submissions, whether they are accepted or not. We are happy to include a byline of up to three sentences and contact information for the author. Like the article itself, the Lilac Tree reserves the right to add additional authors or edit the author's byline for clarity, as may be needed.

Editorial Review Process

Once your article or pitch is submitted, it will be sent to our Guest Authors subcommittee for review. If approved by the subcommittee, the article or pitch will be provided to our Marketing Committee for a final vote. All submissions will be considered.

If your article or pitch is approved, we will notify you by email. If we approve your pitch, we ask that you submit the final article within two weeks of acceptance.

Release & Waiver

By submitting your article to the Lilac Tree, you are agreeing to waive any and all ownership interests you have in and to the article, including, without limitation, the right to republish the article elsewhere and create derivative works. The Lilac Tree shall have exclusive rights to the submission and may edit, distribute, display publically, and/or republish the article as it sees fit.
