ICE SAFETY RULES

- Please keep in mind the following policies when skating (and parents, please remind your child of these policies):
 1. The skater wearing the vest has the right of way.
 2. Only one skater on the ice should be wearing the vest.
 3. Skaters taking a lesson have the right of way over general skaters in the session.
 4. Skaters on the harness also have the right away. Please be careful of the harness area.
 5. Please take a look at the ice diagram and try to keep lutz corners open.
 6. Please ask for assistance on where to practice outside of your lesson, if needed.
 7. No talking or socializing by the boards

Right of Way

1. The skater doing a routine to music has the right of way. Orange vests and colorful belts are provided to help identify the skater whose music is being played. Please stay aware of which skater is doing his or her routine and do your best to stay clear of his or her pattern. Please wear the vest or belt when you play your music to help other skaters know you are skating your routine.

Music

1. Program music will be played on a rotational basis. This will be done on the honor system, with the responsibility left to the skaters and coaches.
2. After a skater's music has been played, their music or another program may be put at end of the line to re-enter the rotation. Dance music can take the place of program music.
3. Not everyone will be able to play their music on full sessions due to lengths of programs.
4. Coaches may put the music of the student they are teaching ahead of other skaters. Everyone should appreciate this policy when they are in a lesson enjoying this privilege and graciously accept this policy when they are the ones being asked to wait in line.
5. Please do not stop and restart your music if others are waiting in line.
6. Please handle the music equipment with extreme care.

- If a skater violates any of the above policies they will be spoken to by the ice monitor. If the skater has been given several verbal warnings, the SCCNY board will send an email to the skater (parent) and coach. If the skater has another infraction after that, the skater will be required to retake the ice safety class.
