PROJECT DETAILS

- Project to be done as a home task throughout the term, beginning Week 3.
- All children are encouraged to participate and display their work at the Expo. They will then present to their class.
- All entries will receive a certificate.
- Students can complete their project individually or submit a project as a family.
- There will be a variety of categories – an explanation sheet with all success criteria will be provided together with some ideas to get the conversation started. These include a working model, an invention, a board game, photography and more.

- Week 3 - Students will be talking in their class and in Science class about ideas for projects.
- Week 10 - Projects are due and can be brought to school throughout the week.
- June 22 - Science Expo. Work is to be displayed in the hall, all students to visit throughout the day.
