

# PHOTOGRAPHY

Think about a scientific principle or phenomenon that you are interested in. It may be something that you observe on a regular basis, eg: the changing shape of the moon, the changing tides, flowers budding, the seasons, plants attracting animals, animal studies. Your photos can be mounted on a poster A2 or on separate smaller sheets. Your poster must include:

- The science behind your photos
- Tell us a little about how you came upon the idea
- List your references and resources
- Acknowledge (thank) anyone who helped you

Here are some ideas for photography projects, perhaps you can think of your own:

Capture the changing colour of the leaves on a tree in your backyard

Capture the stages of growth of the pea plants in your veggie garden

Photograph local birdlife along Sweetwater Creek

Create a photo story of environmental issues in your neighbourhood

Photograph your favourite sunsets and present them as a series of prints
