Friday morning

Preschool Program

A short concert/ song session for preschoolers on a theme of your choice

Day School Program

Engaging morning *t'fillah*, Shabbat sing-along, concert, or experiential learning program

Friday Night

Family Service

Prayers, song, and story create a sacred container for grown-ups and their children to experience meaningful moments together

Adult Services

Spirited *Kabbalat Shabbat* and/or *ma'ariv*, incorporating traditional nusach, sacred chant, and/or modern melodies
