## AS YOU READ

Reading your Bible can be both confusing and intimidating. Whether you're a beginner or not, here's a pattern to follow:

- **PRAYER-** Thank God for who He is and what He has done.  
Ask Him to speak to you through His Word.
- **SCRIPTURE-** Read the passage listed in the guide.
- **REFLECTION-** Think about and write down your answers:
  - 1) What does this teach us about God?
  - 2) What has God done for us?
  - 3) Who are we because of what God has done for us?
  - 4) How would we live if we believed this?
- **PRAYER-** Ask God to enable you do what He shows you and take time to pray for others.
