United Way of Southwest Michigan Value Add

48 Programs Funded @ 32 partner agencies in 2014 - Local dollars support local programs that help local people.

63,367 people served in 2014 - Almost one in three people in Berrien and Cass counties was directly impacted by the funding that United Way invested in community programs.

\$2,219,259 leveraged through United Way Funding - When programs receive state and federal grants, they often have to show that there is local support for those programs. United Way dollars are used as that match.

Total Value of United Way Services \$7,339,268 - Between the dollars we raise, the knowledge we invest, the volunteers we mobilize, and the leverage we provide, United Way of Southwest Michigan provides tremendous value to our community.

35,528 total United Way volunteer hours equals \$801,156 in service - United Way had 1,558 volunteers in 2014 from our Days of Action, internal programs, campaign coordinators, AmeriCorps members, and leadership committees.

Community Collaborations - United Way also plays an integral role by collaborating across our community. This collaborative mentality has helped establish Be Healthy Berrien, the Local College Access Network, and the Great Start Collaborative of Berrien County.
