## About the Diaper Bank

The San Francisco Diaper Bank (SFDB) is a program of Help a Mother Out, in collaboration with the SF Human Services Agency and Family Resource Centers. SFDB serves CalWORKs, CalFresh, and Medi-Cal families with children under 3 years old. Eligible families may receive a month's supply of diapers by visiting designated diaper distribution sites.

## How does the Diaper Bank work?

### IS THERE A COST FOR DIAPERS?

Diapers are free of charge for all Diaper Bank eligible families.

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR DIAPERS?

CalWORKs, CalFresh, and Medi-Cal families with children under the age of 3 are eligible for the diaper bank. Eligible families will receive a letter from San Francisco Human Services Agency with instructions for how to participate.

### WHERE DO I GET THE DIAPERS?

At 12 distribution centers in San Francisco; the locations and diaper distribution hours are listed inside this brochure.

### WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING TO THE DIAPER DISTRIBUTION CENTER TO RECEIVE DIAPERS?

Bring your EBT or BIC card and a valid government issued ID card (e.g., driver's license, Consular ID card).

### WHAT IF I DON'T HAVE A VALID GOVERNMENT ISSUED ID?

Call the CalWORKs Service Center at (415) 557-5100  
If you are a CalFresh or Medi-Cal client call the CalFresh/Medi-Cal Service Center at (415) 558-4700.

### WHAT IF I LOST MY EBT OR BIC CARD?

Call the CalWORKs Service Center at (415) 557-5100 to request a new card and it can be issued the same day at 170 Otis St., San Francisco, CA 94103, or by mail.  
If you are a CalFresh or Medi-Cal Client contact CalFresh/Medi-Cal Service Center at (415) 558-4700 to request a new card and it can be issued the same day at a San Francisco Human Services Agency office location, or by mail.

### WHAT IF I AM ON CAL-LEARN?

If you are on Cal-Learn and have a child under age 3, you are eligible for diapers. Bring your eligibility letter to a participating Family Resource Center during diaper distribution hours.

### HOW MANY DIAPERS WILL I GET?

Each eligible child will receive a full month's supply (up to 2 cases a month).

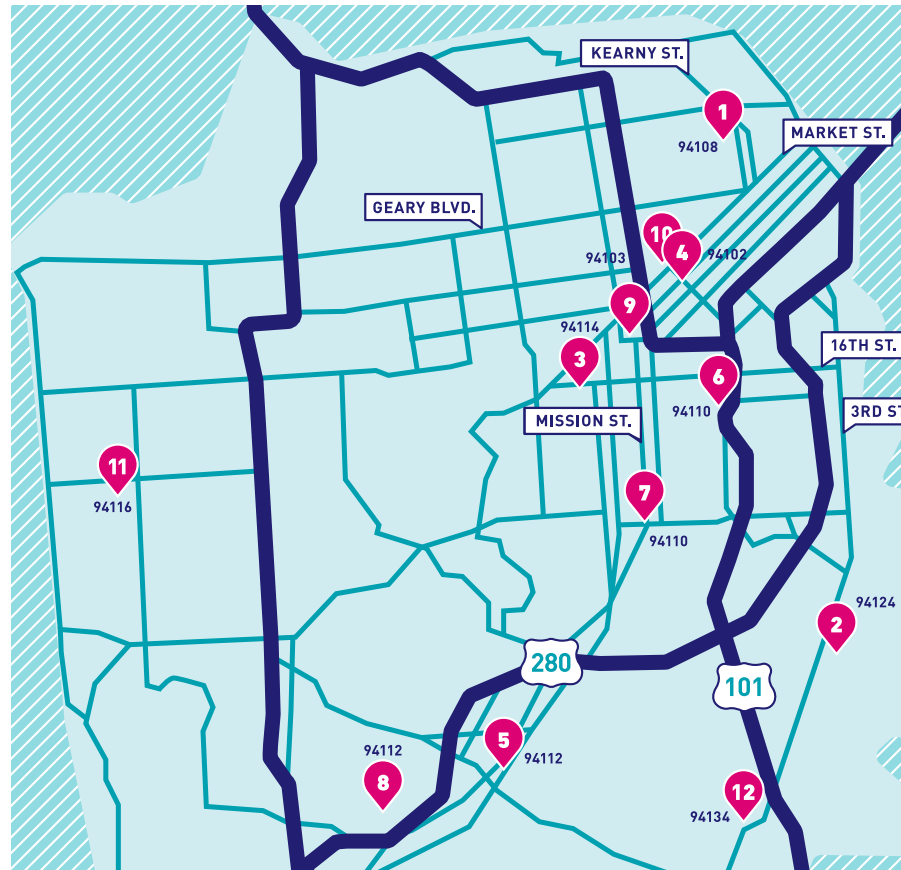
