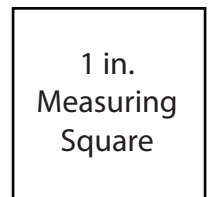




DIY Bucket Hat

Seam allowance: 1/4" or 0.6 cm

This template is 'one size fits all' however shrink to 75% for smaller size, and 50% for infants when printing. Need a larger size, print at 115% for a large size and 125% for extra large. The measuring squares will also increase in size when you re-size this way. Alternatively measure around the band/circumference of the head and adjust the pattern accordingly.

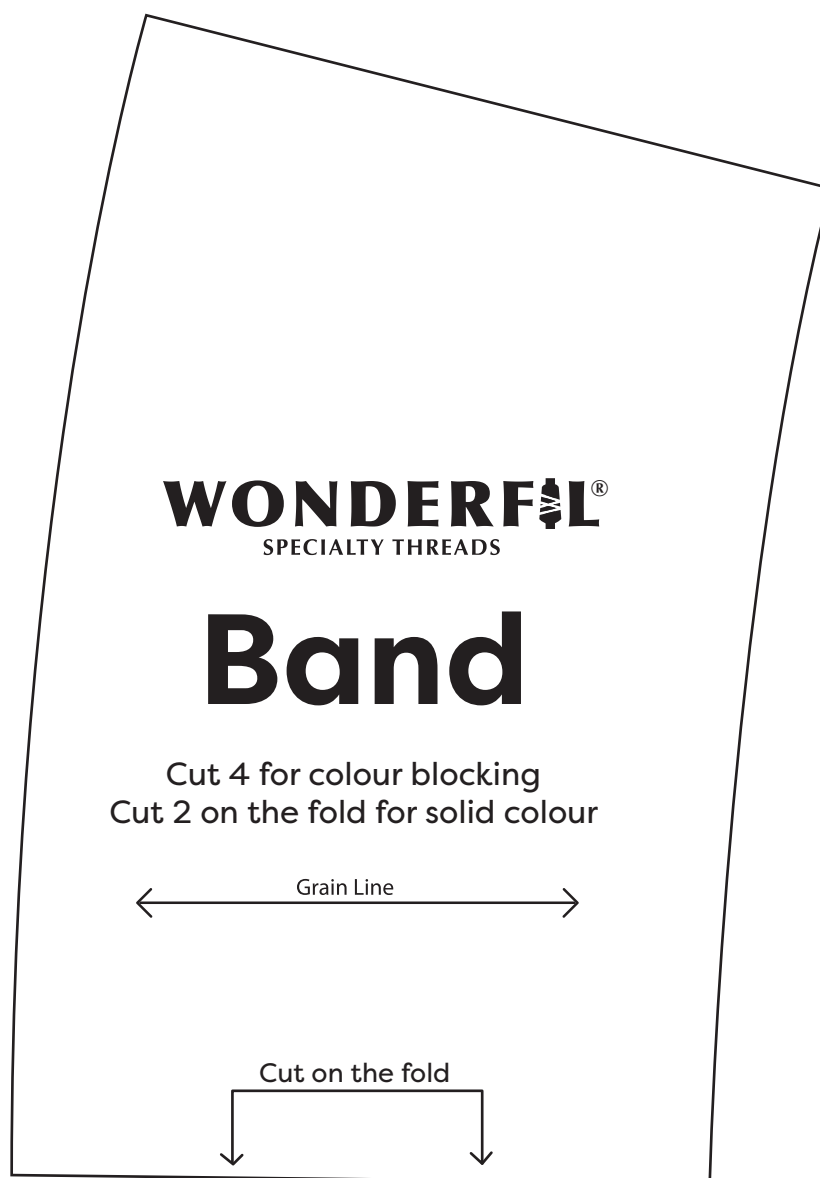
Cut 4 for colour blocking

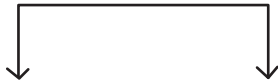

Cut on the fold



To Create the ties:

1. After cutting out the fabric, fold in and press a small bit (about 1/4") on the short end of the fabric strip.
2. Fold and press the long ends so that they meet in the center of the fabric strip.
3. Fold and press the strip in half.
4. Pin in place and top stitch down both long edges of the tie.
5. Sew the ties into what will be the inside of your bucket hat before you stitch the inner and outer pieces of the bucket hat together.
