Lenten Devotional: Called to Serve

*For the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve,
and to give his life as a ransom for many. Matthew 20:20*

These are some of the most startling words uttered from the mouth of Jesus.

The Gospel of Luke doesn't include this exact saying of Jesus, but it is implied on every page. Jesus uses his authority and power to heal, forgive, restore, and embrace outcasts and sinners. We'll see it even more explicitly in this season of Lent as Jesus turns his face toward Jerusalem. Jesus calls us to take up our cross and follow him. It is a call to humble service and sacrificial giving.

I wonder: In what ways is God calling and equipping you to serve him and others daily?

This Lenten booklet is meant to help you engage this journey by dwelling in scripture. It also provides options for how you might serve. Consider at least one way you might step out and try something, whether it is helping serve coffee on Sunday mornings, being an usher, joining the Praise Team, helping out with Hand2Hand, or getting involved in a service opportunity in your neighborhood or the wider community. We'll also have a few church-wide service opportunities that we can do together.

The important thing is that we are all getting into action as disciples in some way, joining Jesus by taking up our cross and joyfully assuming the posture of a servant for God's glory and our neighbor's good.
