1 Kings 5:1-7; 9:1-9 | October 26

Journal it. Ask a friend. Discuss it in a group.

Reflect | Think about a time when someone's reputation or character opened (or closed) doors for you. What kind of reputation are you building through your daily choices?

Excavate | Read 1 Kings 5:1–7 and 9:1–9. What do these passages reveal about Solomon's relationship with God, and how others (like Hiram) perceived his leadership?

Interpret | What does Solomon's wisdom and God's covenant teach us about the connection between divine favor and faithful obedience?

Examine | In what ways might you, like Solomon, be tempted to rely on your achievements or reputation instead of remaining faithful to God's commands?

Apply | Where is God calling you to pursue peace, integrity, or wisdom in your current relationships or responsibilities?

Invite | Ask God to renew your heart toward humble obedience and to make your life a reflection of His faithfulness—so others, like Hiram, might see His goodness through you.
