Trinity Episcopal Cathedral seeks a part-time Tenor Section Leader for the Cathedral Choir. The cathedral's music program focuses on traditional choral music and hymnody, with the pipe organ as the primary instrument. The choir of 30 members sings a full range of music in the Anglican choral tradition, ranging from plainsong chant through music of the best modern composers. We are seeking a professional singer with excellent vocal and sightreading skills who can also provide positive leadership and encouragement to the volunteer singers in the section. The choir year begins in late August and runs through Trinity Sunday (late May or early June, depending on the year).

**Position description**

The section leader will:

- Prepare his vocal part independently prior to rehearsals
- Provide vocal leadership and support within the specified section
- Attend and participate in all Wednesday evening and Sunday morning rehearsals
- Sing for the 10:30 a.m. Eucharist each Sunday
- Sing for 7:00 p.m. Compline liturgy and its preceding rehearsal on the second Sunday of the month
- Assist the Canon Precentor by leading section rehearsals when needed
- Prepare solos and ensembles as requested by the Canon Precentor
- Sing for additional liturgies (Christmas Eve, Holy Week, etc.) and related special rehearsals
- Demonstrate liturgical leadership in worship by modeling appropriate demeanor, posture, movement, and attentiveness
