

## SUP Britain Support Team Roles

SUP Britain is Fiona Quinn's attempt to become the first person to stand up paddleboard the length of Britain, from Lands End to John O'Groats. Paddling 800 miles and taking up to 6 months, she'll travel with a live on support boat up the west coast of Britain.

There are two roles available on board the support boat.

### Skipper

With a Coastal Skipper qualification you'll be experienced in sailing and navigating British waters. You'll be responsible for all things boat related and helping Fiona plan the route, including finding suitable mooring locations

### Media Manager

Coming from either a PR or photography background you'll be eager to maximize the publicity of SUP Britain and capture photo/video of the expedition. You'll also be responsible for helping to manage daily tasks.

#### Key skills:

- Experienced and confident coastal skipper; or,
- Experienced and confident in either PR or photography
- Keen to explore
- Sociable with good communication skills
- Able to get stuck in and work as part of a team, while leading on core tasks.

Both positions are unpaid but will have full expenses covered for the role, including travel to and from the boat, accommodation and food/drink.

Must be available for a minimum of 3 months, preferably up to 6 months to cover the full expedition.

As a world first, this expedition provides an incredible opportunity to develop your contacts, portfolio and experience in adventure photography/PR or to utilize your coastal sailing skills to explore parts of Britain that few people have seen. While it will sometimes be challenging, it will also be incredibly fun and an adventure you'll never forget.
