SUP Britain is Fiona Quinn's attempt to become the first and fastest person to stand up paddleboard the length of Britain, from Lands End to John O'Groats (LEJOG). Leaving mid April she'll paddle 800 miles taking up to 6 months, travelling with a live on support boat up the west coast of Britain.

Having already cycled and walked LEJOG, completing the SUP will also see her become the first woman to do a length of Britain triathlon.

With a yacht master qualification you'll be experienced in sailing and navigating British waters. You'll be responsible for all things boat related and helping Fiona plan the route for the section you'll be supporting, including finding suitable mooring locations.
