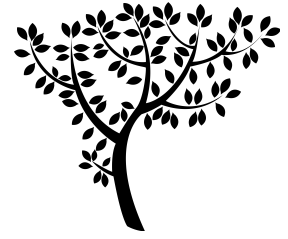


The Park School

SCHOOL DAY



The Park School day is organised on a secondary model. Students benefit from a year tutor who oversees their pastoral needs and academic progress. Students are taught by specialist teachers and move to specific classrooms, labs and studios for their lessons throughout the day.

8.30 - 9.00	Breakfast club (no cost)
9.00 - 9.10	Registration in tutor groups
9.10 - 9.25	Whole school reading: everyone in school reading for pleasure in small ability groups to support their reading development
9.25 - 10.15	Lesson 1
10.15 - 10.30	Break time: a 15 minute break between lessons supervised by staff. Students are able to purchase healthy snacks at the school tuck shop
10.30 - 11.20	Lesson 2
11.20 - 12.15	Lesson 3
12.15 - 1.00	Lunch time: lunch in the hall for KS3 and in the cafe for KS4. Students are encouraged to have a cooked lunch as well as a selection of salads and healthy desserts. All dietary needs are catered for.
	After lunch: A 30 minute break. This provides a chance for the students to go to a full range of clubs, sporting activities or have some free time with their friends
1.00 - 1.10	Registration in tutor groups
1.10 - 2.05	Lesson 4
2.05 - 3.00	Lesson 5
3.00 - 3.15	Tutor time: an opportunity for reflection at the end of the day, reviewing progress in lessons and preparing students for events that may take place the following day
3.15	Students depart

Assemblies

There are regular key stage and whole school assemblies celebrating successes, students reporting on recent events with a focus on a weekly reflection theme. Parents are regularly invited to join us.
