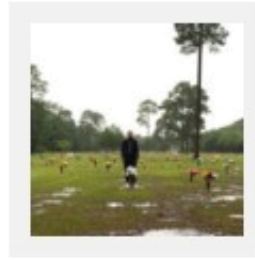
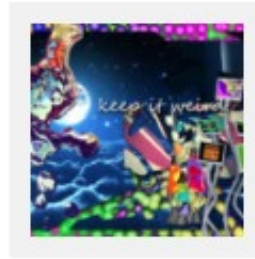
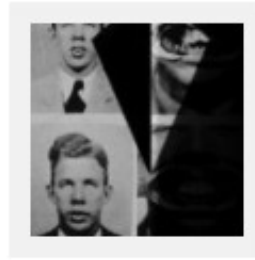
New York's Alden Projects will offer Eleanor Antin's *100 Boots Entering the Museum*.
