The South Dakota Department of Transportation (SDDOT), in conjunction with Meade County, will hold open house style public meetings for the Meade County Transportation Plan Update. The Meade County Transportation Plan Update will address a full range of transportation options and issues, including pedestrian, bicycle, transit, freight, and automobile from a countywide perspective. The purpose of these public meetings is to gather information on community needs and desires as input into a long-range, multi-modal plan that will provide a blueprint to address the future transportation needs of Meade County.
