4th Annual Livestock Extravaganza




This 4th Annual Event will be held Saturday, **June 6, 10 AM** at the **Nisland Fairgrounds**. Events will include two full

South Dakota 4-H has committed to host three young adults from Europe and Asia who are in their 20's as part of South Dakota 4-H International Exchange Programs. At the time of this writing, many short-term host families are still needed. These young people would like to experience a variety of South Dakota living during their stay, so each family hosts for three weeks or less. They are placed as individuals and just do what the family is doing at the time of their stay. They will be up for anything from farm work to sightseeing. There is no requirement that you attend specific events or expectation that they be entertained. They hope to become a member of your family!

They in turn will bring their culture and perspective to enrich your family...a great opportunity for the young people and children in your lives to gain an international perspective as well as learn about a specific country and its culture.

There is no requirement that hosts have children or that children be a specific age, but families with teens and their own young adults often help provide social outlets and engage in contemporary discussions. Families often introduce them to 4-H members and neighbors during their stay. 4-H'ers are introduced to the opportunity to travel abroad by getting to know an inbound IFYE!

If youth sign-up to take animals to State, be sure to check the State Fair Handbook for information on fees, stalling requirements, etc. Remember, all YIA and animals going to State must be registered in <http://buttelawrencecofair.fairentry.com> by August 1.
