What Parents Should Know

- Registration fee is \$45.00/ 4-H camper and \$55.00/ non-4-H camper. This includes a camp t-shirt and everything else but the camp store, which is open daily for campers to buy snacks and camp souvenirs.
- 4-H camp is open to all youth ages 8-12 by camp deadline. You do not have to be a 4-H member to attend. Invite a friend!
- This camp is not a nut free camp due to ingredients used and camp store. Food allergies need be called in by June 1 to Head Cook.
- Every county must provide one chaperone for every 12 kids of each gender attending camp. Camp registration forms will not be accepted without adequate supervision lined up! Chaperones must have the 4-H State Volunteer form on file with the State 4-H Office before attending camp.
- A talent/variety show will be held. Please bring what you need to share your talent with the camp.
- Please plan your arrival for no earlier than 2:00 p.m. on the first day of camp and your departure no earlier than 10:30 a.m. and no later than 11:30 a.m. on the last day of camp. **An adult from each county needs to stay until all campers have left camp!**
- There are many counties at each camp, numbers fill up fast, check with your county on their cap of numbers for campers.
- The Camper Information Form must be filled out and on file for **all** campers and chaperones!
- **Please note:** The South Dakota 4-H Code of Conduct is enforced at all 4-H Camp functions!
