How to Sign Up

If you have Internet at home:

1. Go to www.sdcl.org/summer
2. Click on "Sign Up Here."
3. Fill out the form and click "Save."
4. Use your "travel document" from the library to keep track of your adventures at home.

If you don't have Internet at home:

1. Visit a catalog computer at the library. Click on the "Catalog" icon.
2. Click on the "Summer Reading Challenge" icon.
3. Click on "Sign Up Here."
4. Fill out the form and click "Save."
5. Pick up a paper reading log at the reference desk to keep track of your reading at home.

If you want to register as a group/family:

1. Sign up one group/family member and save the account.
2. Click on the "Add Member" button above the "Activity Center" on your account homepage.
3. On the pop-up, click the right age for each additional group/family member and click "Continue."
4. Fill out the form and click "Save."
