

**A**RISE, O Lord, &c., with other antiphons, the seven penitential psalms, and collects as on Monday and Tuesday, but with this conclusion:

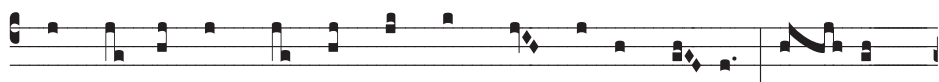

one God, world without end. Amen.






