### **New Parish Directory**

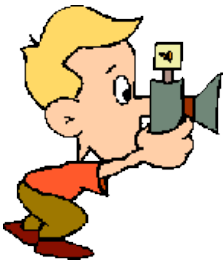
It's hard to believe but it's been a whole decade since we last published a parish directory!
