



All You Knit is Love Blanket

Straight knitting needles

Level: ●●●●●



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Send us an email letting us know how many you've made or plan to make, and we'll let you know where to post them.

Materials

Super chunky wool
(We use Wool and the Gang's Crazy Sexy Wool)
15mm straight knitting needles
Knitter's sewing needle

Tension

10cm x 10cm = 7 stitches and 10 rows

Finished size

Per square: 20cm x 20cm
Finished blanket: 140cm x 180cm

Pattern

- 1 Cast on 14 stitches
- 2 Knit every row until your piece measures 20cm in length.
- 3 Cast off all stitches.
- 4 Cut yarn leaving a long tail of around 60cm. This will be used to stitch the square to another square to create the blanket.
- 5 Weave in cast on end.

Stitching together

When you knit every row, this is called the **garter stitch**. This stitch creates a pattern that runs horizontally. When sewing together the squares, you will stitch together one square with garter stitch running horizontally and another square with garter stitch running vertically. This gives the blanket a lovely texture and helps to maintain its shape.

Stitch your squares together using the invisible seam method.

The size of the finished blanket is approximately 140cm wide x 180 cm in length. This is made up of 7 squares stitched together for the width and 9 rows for the length.
