The Environmental Action Committee of West Marin (EAC) would like to invite you to become a **Friend of the Festival** for the 9th annual Point Reyes Birding and Nature Festival (April 27th-29th).

Held on the last weekend of April, **the festival celebrates spring bird and wildlife migration, the 2018 Year of the Bird Campaign, the 100th Anniversary of the Migratory Bird Act**, our ongoing work to protect nesting birds in Marin, and the integrity of the Migratory Bird Treaty Act.

Point Reyes National Seashore provides the backdrop for our festival, where the Pacific Flyway, Pacific Ocean, and other influences provide **an ideal location for birding and wildlife viewing**. In fact, the area was **named the #1 birding hotspot in 2017, where over 54% of all North American bird species have been recorded**.

Over the three day weekend over 400 attendees choose from **50+ educational field outings and classroom-based events focused on birds, wildlife, plants and marine life + hiking, biking, kayaking, art and field photography**, and led by some of the Bay Area's award-winning naturalists and birders. These events are **geared to bring a broader awareness, appreciation and stewardship of the area** to novice and expert birders/naturalists alike.

**The annual festival proceeds provide vital funding for our ongoing nonprofit mission**, especially around our current programming to protect nesting birds in Marin and advocate for the integrity of the Migratory Bird Treaty Act. # EAC FACT SHEET



## Mission

**Protect and sustain the unique lands, waters, and biodiversity of West Marin.**

## Vision

**Our work strives to provide long-term protection and conservation of the unique ecosystems and rural communities of West Marin, and serves as a foundation of environmental protection for future generations.**

The Environmental Action Committee of West Marin (EAC) is a 501(3)(c) environmental nonprofit centrally located in Point Reyes Station, California, the gateway town to the only national seashore on the West Coast. For nearly 47-years we have remained engaged in the protection of West Marin's unique lands, waters and biodiversity through advocacy, engagement and education. Located just an hour from San Francisco, our work focuses on large scale environmental threats facing the unincorporated coastal communities of West Marin from Dillon to Muir beaches. West Marin is the largest rural region of Marin County, California, and is home to approximately 16,000 people, or about 6.5% of the population of Marin County, and receives over 2+ million visitors a year in search of respite, relaxation, and recreation.

As one of the only local environmental nonprofits taking on multi-year, and sometimes decade-long campaigns to address environmental threats, we provide an essential voice on behalf of the West Marin's priceless natural resources. We accomplish our work by bringing people, science, and policy together to protect vital ecosystems, defend critical legislation, enforce accountability of our leaders and legislators, and rally our community to become stewards of their community. Often our efforts are not fought over night, so your long-term support and generosity is critical to our ongoing efforts to ensure environmental protection measures are in place and lasting.

## SOME OF EAC'S KEY ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Advocated for the conservation and protection of the Giacomini Wetlands with a organized and well-publicized sail-in, which successfully stopped the construction of a levee.
- Participated in the community effort to stop the controversial Countywide Plan that would have constructed a six-lane highway from the Golden Gate Bridge to Point Reyes and intensely developed the area.
- Stopped the expansion of the West Marin dump through a decade long struggle.
- Banned the use of jet skis in the Greater Farallones National Marine Sanctuary including Tomales Bay.
- Protected Estero Americano and Estero San Antonio when the City of Santa Rosa proposed to dump its sewage into these estuaries. Later, EAC stopped developers who proposed to build Marin Coast Golf Ranch at the mouth of Estero San Antonio.
- Protected the Tomales Dunes-wetlands complex at Lawson's Landing (after 40 years of advocacy), striking a balance between protecting environmentally sensitive habitat and supporting the continued operation of this large, family-owned coastal campground.
- Led the effort to secure international recognition for Tomales Bay as a Ramsar Site, or Wetland of International Importance.
- Stopped construction of industrial wind turbines along the ridgelines of the east shore of Tomales Bay.
- Successfully advocated for the designation of Drakes Estero Wilderness in Point Reyes National Seashore.
