

Every month the mission team is focusing on a people group to pray for; this month we are focusing on Mongolia. It is a country in central Asia with 2.7 million residents. Mongolia, which is only 1.7 percent Christian, only has 20 full time missionaries. For the first time in modern history, Christianity in Mongolia is becoming an actuality. Today, in providential centers found in Mongolia's capital city there are over 200 churches and believers. Despite this growth of Christianity there are several areas that have presented challenges to the spreading of Christianity. Rural Churches have very little support and teaching due to the lack of finances and distance from the capital. As a result an effective nomadic church concept has yet to be established. Another major challenge facing the church is the foreignness of Christianity since Mongolians' cling to their cultural beliefs, ancestors, and the sense of anti-foreign culture that has been established. Many missionaries enter with inadequate cross-cultural preparation they need to be adequate on the field. Pray for a better contextualization of biblical truths to fit the Mongolian culture, support for rural churches, and that Christ will become known and glorified throughout this country. Will you join me this month in praying for the Mongolians people and for God to move in this country.


