Admissions Policy

Penn Hall School is a Wolverhampton Local Authority Community Special School for pupils aged 3 – 18+ whose special educational needs fall predominantly within the category of Physical Disability, although other needs may be evident.

In particular many pupils will have associated learning difficulties arising out of, or related to their physical disability.

In addition some pupils may have complex medical conditions, and/or communication impairment, and/or sensory loss.

Before admission their case must be considered and they should be the subject of a statement of Special Educational Needs. Exceptions may be made, especially with very young children where an assessment place can be offered.

Admissions and Transfers – Pupils may be admitted throughout the year.

The school constantly examines pupil progress to ensure that the setting it offers is the right one.

Residential Facility

Penn Hall School offers a unique facility within the city providing an opportunity for young people to stay in the residential facility. The introduction and admission to the facility is on a phased basis and appropriate to each child's individual need.

The journey begins with a number of introductory tea visits, will extend over time to a stay of a full week (Monday – Friday) and will be tailored to suit each child.

This experience proves invaluable in the personal development of each child increasing their independence skills leading to smooth transition to extended residential stays and further education opportunities.
