What to Expect

Supported Recovery

At Telecare Transitional Age Youth (TAY) Behavioral Health Team, you have the opportunity to connect with a group of people who are here to be your support team. We believe that recovery is a deeply personal experience and will do whatever it takes to support your journey during your time with us.

Our program is staffed with a multidisciplinary team to assist you. This includes a psychiatrist, nurse, master's prepared clinician, case managers, housing specialists, employment specialists, and family peer support specialists with experience in substance use recovery, housing, employment, and mental health support.

Our services are individualized to meet your needs and hope for recovery. We also partner with and connect you to a variety of community services and resources wherever needed.

When you work with us, you can expect the following:

- **Our staff** are passionate, resourceful, and motivated. They are your partners in recovery.
- Our culture is based on respect and non-judgment, and we celebrate individual uniqueness. We care about the interpersonal relationships we develop so we can maintain a supportive program setting.
- **Our goal** is to be a place where recovery can thrive, and you feel empowered to create the life you want for yourself.

Who is Served

- Residents of Stanislaus County, ages 18 25.
- Members may have Medi-Cal or be uninsured/underserved.
- Members served may be transitioning from institutional settings like state hospitals, IMDs, or other locked psychiatric facilities. These individuals may also have a history of multiple psychiatric hospitalizations, incarcerations or arrests, or a co-occurring substance use concern, and/or a history of homelessness.
