At the Heritage Psychiatric Health Facility (PHF), we provide intensive mental health and psychiatric treatment services in a safe, welcoming environment for adults experiencing a mental health emergency.

We believe recovery starts from within, and that our job is to do whatever it takes to provide the support needed on your recovery journey in a comfortable, structured environment. Our secure 26-bed facility has a multidisciplinary team that includes a psychiatrist, social workers, a rehabilitation therapist, registered nurses, recovery specialists, and peer support specialists.

Our services emphasize choice-making skills and harm-reduction techniques. We provide a safe, respectful environment where you can receive immediate, individualized assistance and a compassionate presence to stabilize symptoms, avoid the need for higher levels of care and receive appropriate referrals to community-based resources.

What to Expect

Your recovery plan starts with you. Upon arrival, our diverse clinical team will provide an individualized assessment and work with you every step of the way to support your goals in life.

Our culture is based on recovery. We believe in respect and non-judgment, and we celebrate individual uniqueness. We care about the interpersonal relationships we develop so we can foster a supportive program setting.

Our staff are passionate, resourceful, and motivated. They are your partners in recovery.

Becoming a Member

Clients are referred through Kaiser Call Center. We accept referrals 24 hours a day, 7 days a week through our referral line at 510-915-4977. We cannot accept walk-ins.

Admission Criteria

Kaiser members, aged 18 and older who are experiencing an acute exacerbation of symptoms of mental illness who require 24-hour supervision and/or assistance with psychiatric recovery.

Exclusion Criteria

We cannot accept individuals who:

- Have complex medical problems that cannot be treated on an outpatient basis
- Have a primary diagnosis of drug or alcohol abuse, or an eating disorder (but can be co-occurring)
- Are a registered sex offender
