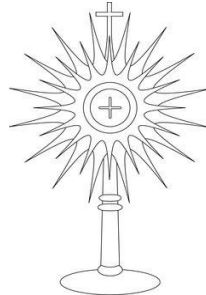

We look forward to seeing those who have kindly accepted the invitation to be members of the Parish Pastoral Council (PPC). Their 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting, is this coming Friday.

Canon Law describes the Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) and the Parish Finance Committee (PFC) in such a way that they are distinct consultative bodies in the Parish because each has responsibility for distinct aspects of Parish life and the membership of each is different.

The PPC has responsibility for: -

- A) Giving counsel to the parish priest (PP) regarding pastoral activity in the parish.
  - B) Assisting the PP and his clergy team in their pastoral role
  - C) Fostering the pastoral life and ministry of the parish
- The PFC has responsibility for: -

- i) Giving counsel to the PP regarding the administration of the parish goods with due regard for Canon Law. The PP represents the parish in all juridical affairs. To this end, the PP establishes a committee – 3 or 4 member is the usual number. These good people enjoy a consultative voice. Membership of the PFC is at the discretion of the PP. Its members, including the PP, constitute the PFC. Simultaneous membership of the PFC and the PPC is not permitted.
- ii) Assisting the PP in his temporal and administrative roles.
- iii) Assisting the PP in his financial matters
- iv) The PP also keeps the PFC up to date on parish projects, costs and the current state of parish finances
