Day 1 Wed 14 th Jun	“ Behold this heart which has so loved men that it has spared nothing, even to the point of spending itself and being consumed to prove it’s love to them”. Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque
Day 2 Thu 15 th Jun	O sweet Jesus, it is here You established the throne of Your mercy To bring joy and hope to sinful man. From Your open Heart, as from a pure fount, Flows comfort to a repentant heart and soul. St. Faustyna’s prayer to Our Lord
Day 3 Fri 16 th Jun	Blessed are the pure in heart , for they will see God. Matthew 5: 8

Suggested ending	Perhaps follow each daily thought, Consecration prayer, Novena Prayer and Litany with : saying the Hail Holy Queen and then “Lord, your heart is still moved today by your people and their many needs. Open our hearts to hear your word, to accept your love, and to respond to your call. In particular, I beg you to grant me the favour I ask during this novena (make you request silently), provided that it will contribute to my own eternal good and to the building up of your Kingdom of justice, peace and love here on earth”
