




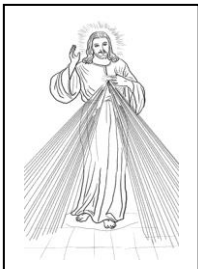

The Fount of Mercy

Fr. Michael writes

In unity with my brother clergy, I wish you and your family, God's peace and Easter Blessing. As a Parish, we have prayed together throughout Lent and especially in our Parish Mission. This has helped us cross a bridge into Holy Week. These past days saw queues for Confession and our beautiful Liturgies of the Lord's Passion, Death and Resurrection, have opened Heaven's door to many blessings. We now look forward to celebrating Christ's victory over death and sin with you over the next 50 days of the Easter Season. During this period, "Alleluia" will be our song of gratitude to our loving God, who raised Jesus from the dead. I urge you to pray the Novena to Divine Mercy which we began on Good Friday and will conclude on the Vigil of Divine Mercy. Next, week 8th April, is Divine Mercy Sunday. All our Masses will honour the Lord of Divine Mercy. Deacon Vincent, will lead our solemn prayer and litanies from 1.15pm next Sunday. Our 3pm Mass sees many journeying to be with us and we look forward to welcoming them. All priests will be hearing Confessions at all Masses on Sunday 8th April. For the 3pm Mass, you have the chance to go to Confession, from 1.15pm to 2.45pm - all priests will be hearing Confessions. The Lord, himself, said to St. Faustyna; "I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls and especially for poor sinners...I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of Mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion (on that day), shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day, all the divine floodgates through which grace flow, are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near me, even though its sins be scarlet."
