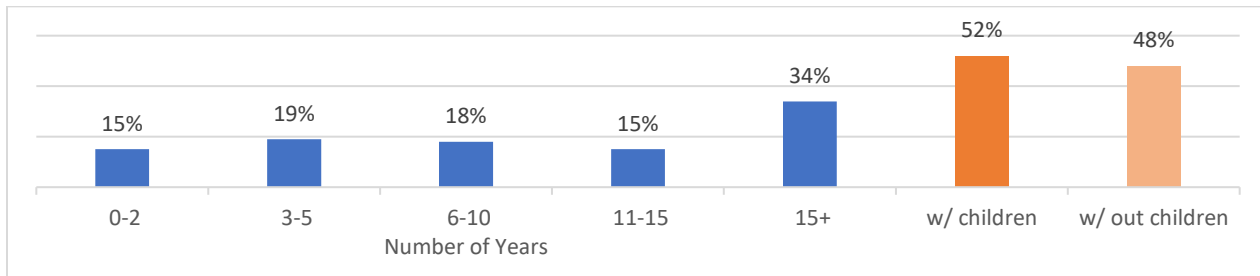

In addition, we had fair participation from both longtime parishioners and newer parishioners. There was equitable interest from those with children attending the school and those who did not have children in the school. The participation results were as follows:



The results will help guide our leadership committees in making decisions moving forward regarding the facilities of our campus. The following results were based on responses to the questions “How Important Is”. The survey allowed a participant to choose every topic as very important it was not ranked or an either/or result. Therefore, each question stands alone, the sum of the results will not equal 100%. However, the higher the percentage the stronger the survey participants felt about the importance of that facility need. The results were as follows:

82% felt it very important to important to have dedicated space for youth & young adult

74% felt it very important to important to have a Community/Welcoming Center

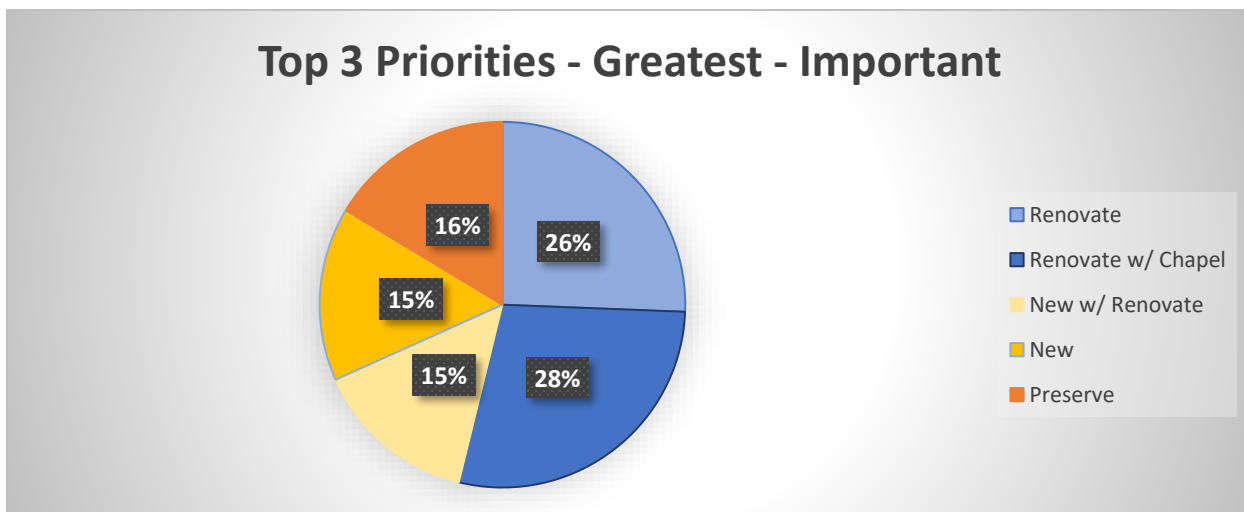
71% felt it very important to important to have to renovate the existing church

70% felt it very important to important to have a Daily and Adoration Chapel

69% felt it very important to important to increase school capacity while lowering classroom size

37% felt it very important to important to construct a new church
