

## VOLUNTEER STATE HORSEMEN'S FOUNDATION (VSHF) RAFFLE RULES, TERMS, AND CONDITIONS OF RAFFLE

1. The Volunteer State Horsemen's Foundation will sell raffle tickets at \$25 each to entrants for the chance to win an 8 person box for the 2018 Iroquois Steeplechase. The raffle is conducted by and all proceeds go to the Volunteer State Horsemen's Foundation, P. O. Box 129, Franklin, TN 37065.
2. The random drawing for the raffle will be on May 11, 2017 at 203 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave. North, Franklin, TN 37064. The winner of the raffle will be announced at the 76<sup>th</sup> running of the Iroquois Steeplechase on May 13, 2017 at Percy Warner Park, Nashville, TN. The raffle entrant does not need to be present to win.
3. The winner of the raffle will be the person who purchases the ticket number that is drawn and meets all eligibility requirements and conditions.
4. Three ticket numbers will be drawn (the winner & 1<sup>st</sup> alternate & 2<sup>nd</sup> alternate in case of failure of winner to qualify or collect prize). The 1<sup>st</sup> alternate number drawn will be the winner, subject to meeting all eligibility requirements and conditions, of the prize in the case of the death, disability, failure to claim, or disqualification of the winner. The 2<sup>nd</sup> alternate winner will be the winner, subject to meeting all eligibility requirements and conditions, of the prize in the case of the death, disability, failure to claim, or disqualification of the 1<sup>st</sup> alternate winner.
5. All entrants must be at least 18 years of age.
6. The winner must claim the prize within thirty (30) days of May 11, 2017, or forfeit the prize.
7. The following persons **ARE NOT ELIGIBLE** to participate in the raffle or to receive the prize:
  - a. Any officer, director, trustee, employee, or agent (or functional equivalent thereof) of VSHF, or any member of the immediate family of such person (spouse, child, step-child, brother, sister, son-in-law,

- daughter-in-law, parent or grandparent) residing as a member of the same household of such person;
- b. Any person providing prizes, facilities, locations, advertising services, printing services, telephone services and any records, devices or other supplies to conduct the raffle, or any officer, employee, agent, or subcontractor of any such person, or any member of the immediate family (spouse, child, step-child, brother, sister, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, parent or grandparent) of any such person residing as a member of the same household of any such person
  - c. Any member of the Tennessee General Assembly;
  - d. The Tennessee Secretary of State or any employee of the Secretary of State;
8. Under no circumstances will there be any refund to any entrant of any portion of the raffle ticket price, including should the entrant be the winner but fail to meet the eligibility requirements and conditions.
  9. By purchasing a raffle ticket, the purchaser agrees to all of the rules, terms, conditions, and requirements set out herein, and hereby releases and forever holds harmless VSHF and its trustees, employees, and agents from any liability in connection with the raffle or the prize.
  10. All tickets, transactions, and winners are subject to the Tennessee Charitable Gaming Event rules and applicable state law.
