Roadworks

Various roadworks have been and continue to be carried out over the next few months, some of which we receive information and others we don't.

Today we have received the following notice below, for your information:

"PROJECT: MCF Chadderton Broadway to Freehold Tram Station SUBJECT – Notice of Construction

I write to in relation to the above-named scheme which is commencing on **09**th **January 2023** and will completed in several phases before the **end of Spring 2023**.

Following the public consultation, the Mayor's challenge Fund (MCF) have awarded funding to Oldham Council to upgrade of the existing pedestrian and cycle route between Broadway through to Freehold tram station to provide better connectivity, by improving the existing footpath, improved drainage, upgrading the street lighting, creating a safer route, and preventing anti-social behaviour.

The route will be from Broadway, along the footpath adjacent to Crossley Playing Fields, on to Rochester Way, left onto Glenby Way, left on to Denton Lane, crossover a new Zebra crossing, leading on to Robinson Street up to Freehold Tram Station.

During the construction phase, there may be pedestrian diversions in place around Crossley Playing Fields which will be clearly sign posted to facilitate the safe working and pedestrian safety. "
