We built towers with repeated patterns.



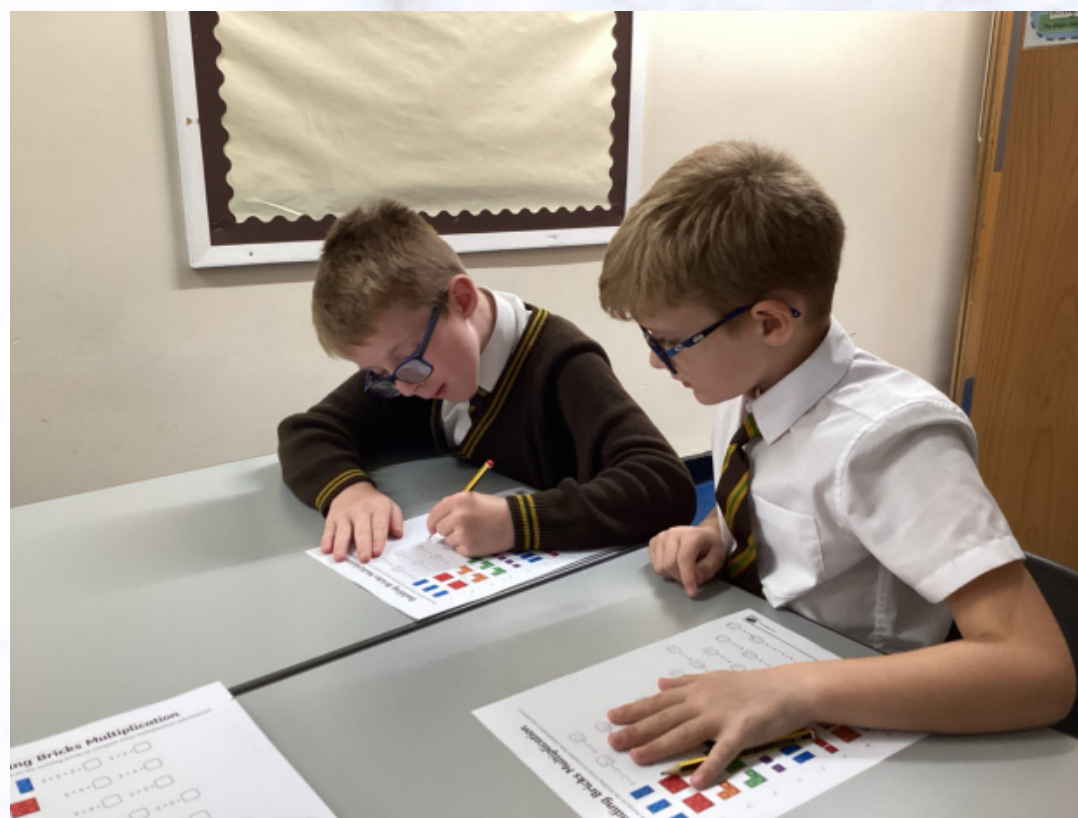

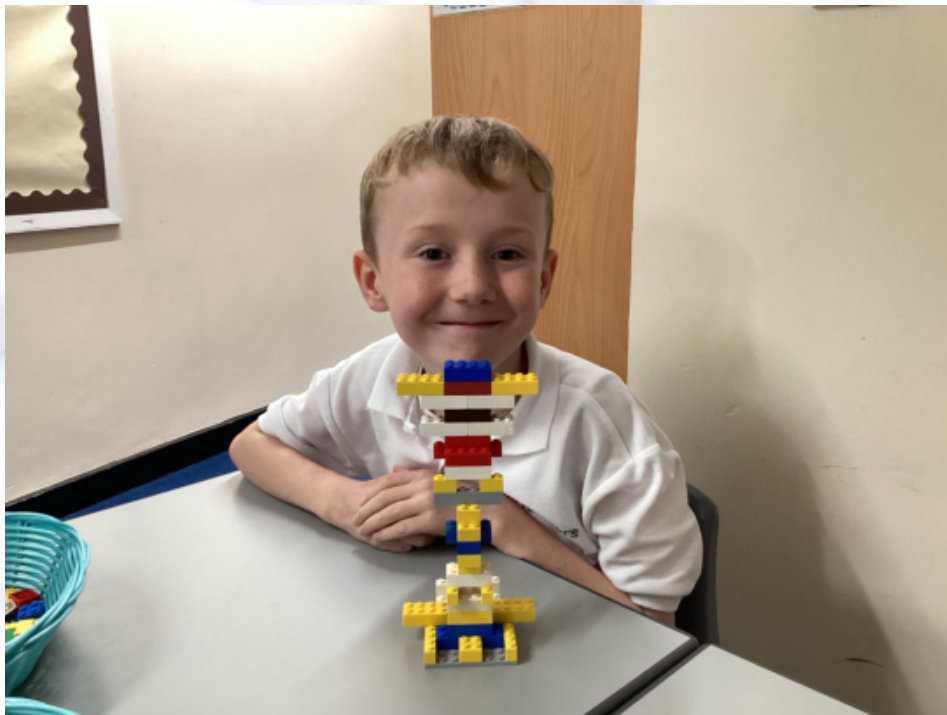
We took turns to instruct each other how to build a model.

We had fun using challenge cards to build models.



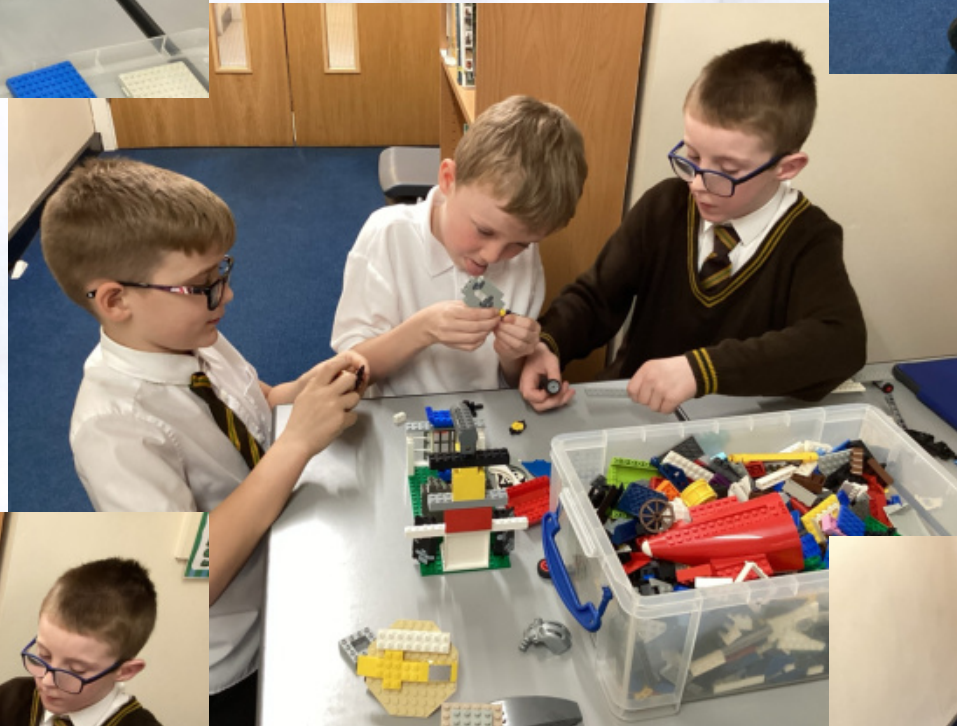
We created our own designs then told each other what we had made.

Fun Friday





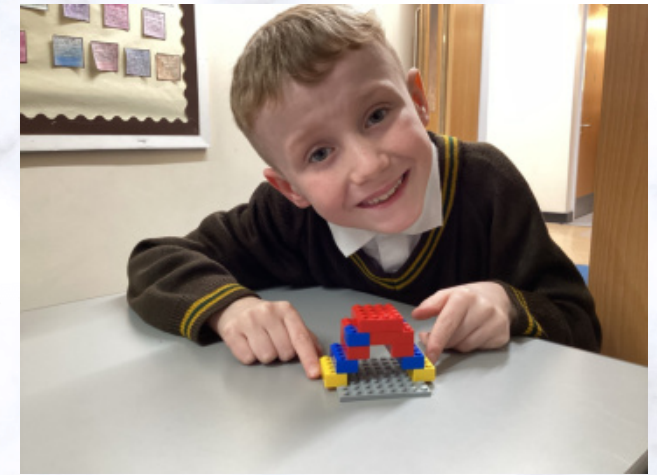
First, we each built an animal and then a pyramid. Then we played a game using the Wheel of Lego Challenges.

We used a template to build these models.



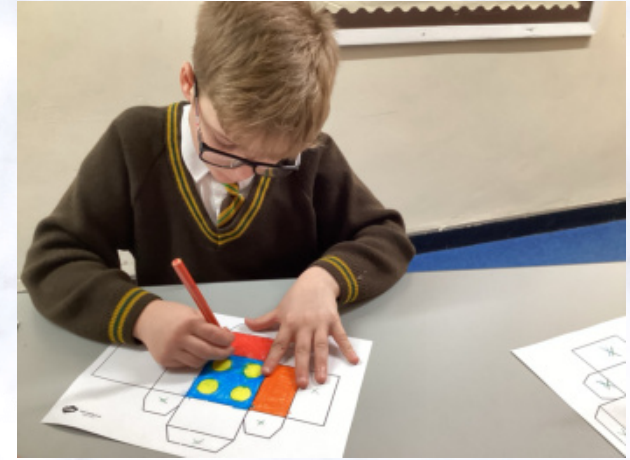
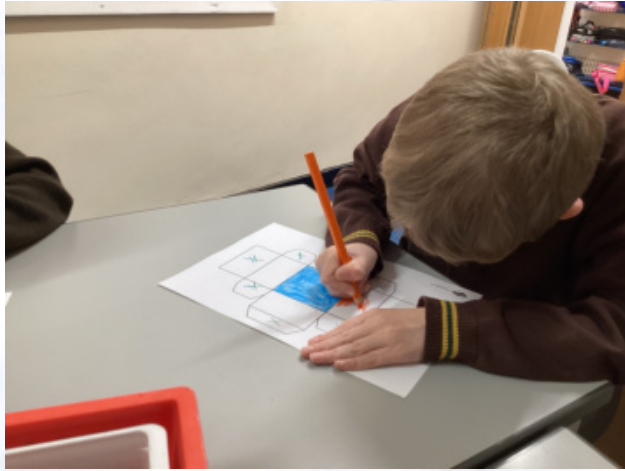
We practiced our pencil control too.

We then used observational skills to colour the template to match what we had built.

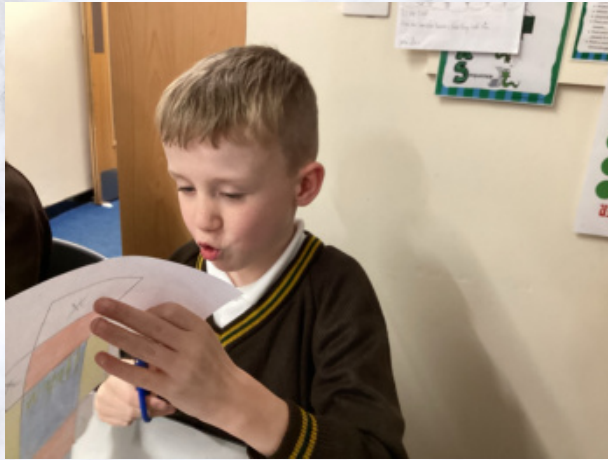


We made Lego bricks using nets.

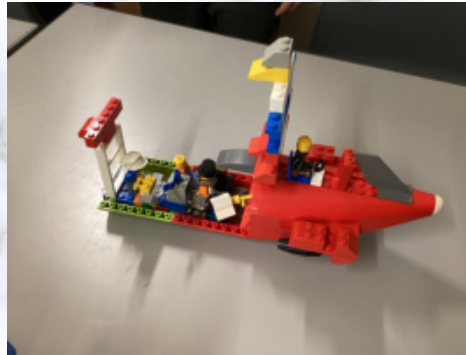


The challenge was to build something beginning with the letter 'M'. So we built a mountain, a motorbike, a moat and the McDonalds' M!

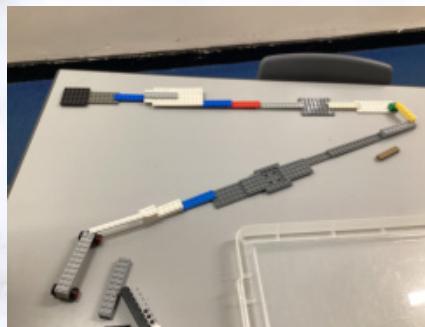


Then we each designed a fire station and described it to the group.

We love building lots of different things with the Lego.



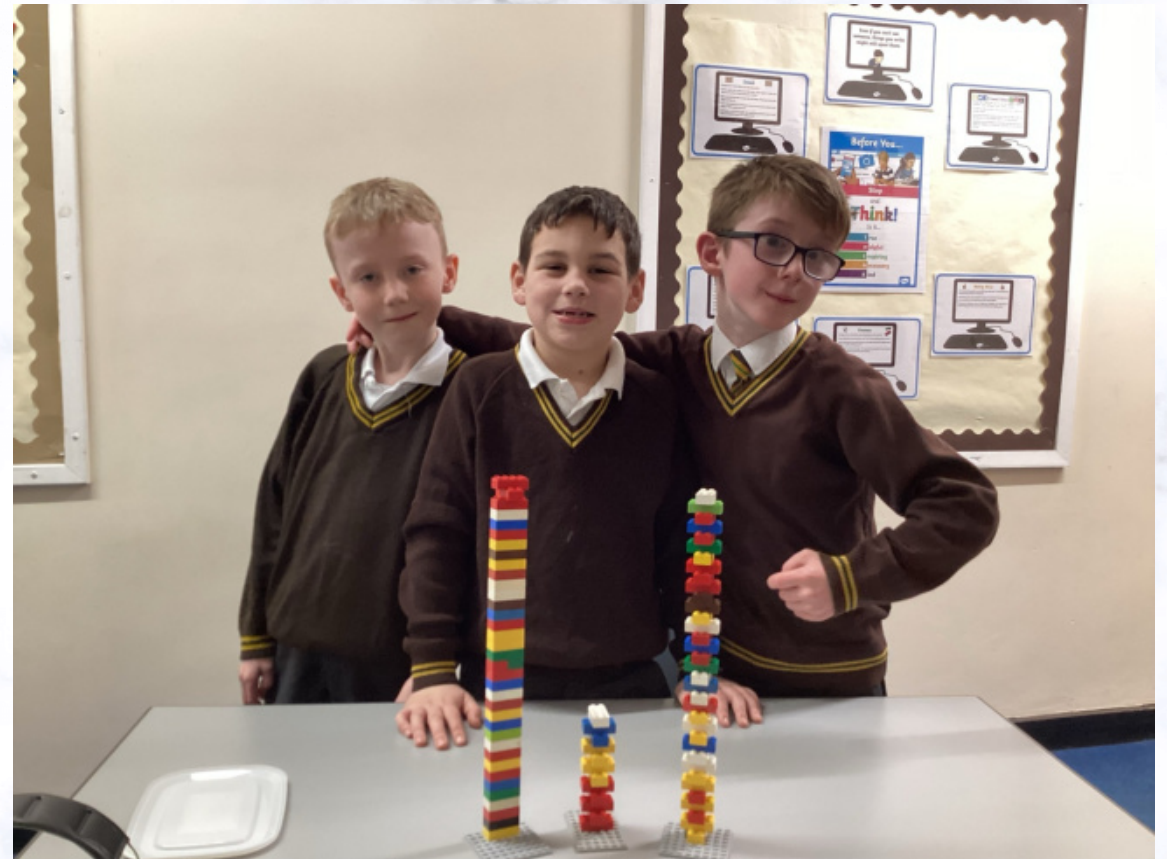

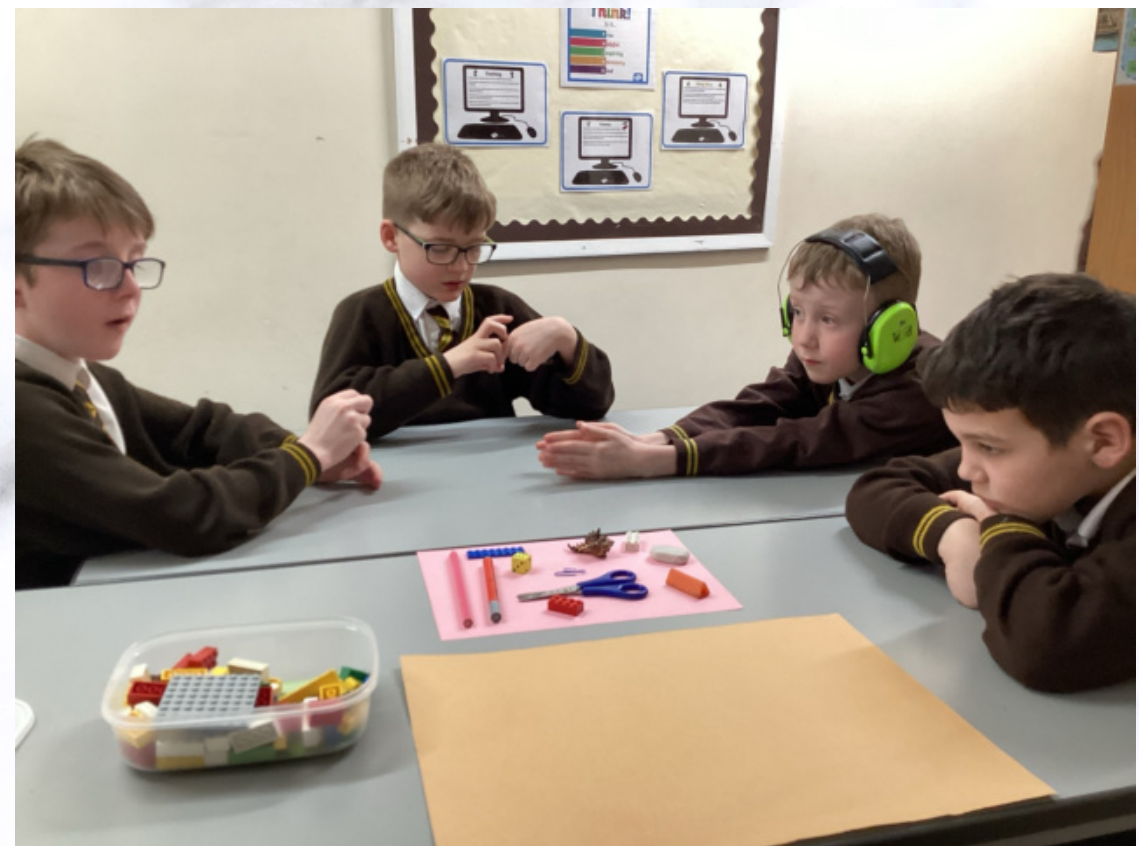
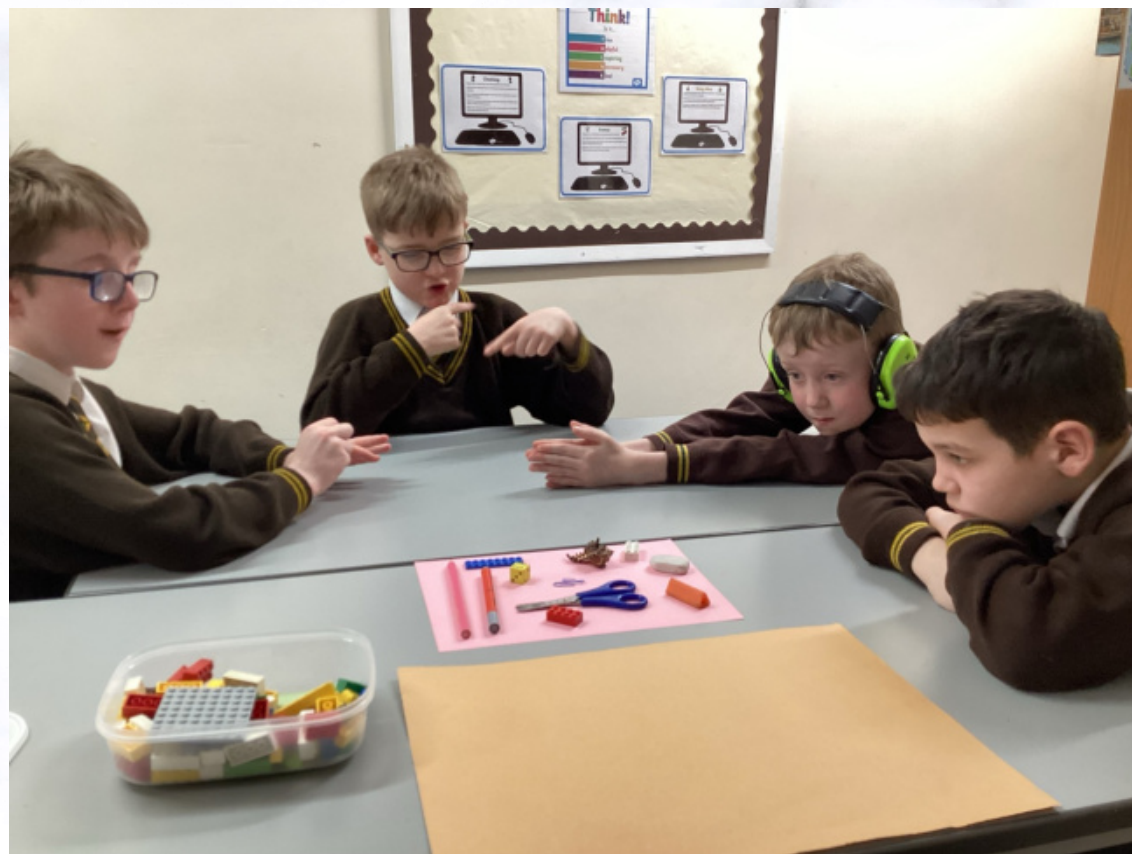
Lego is a good way to relax with friends.





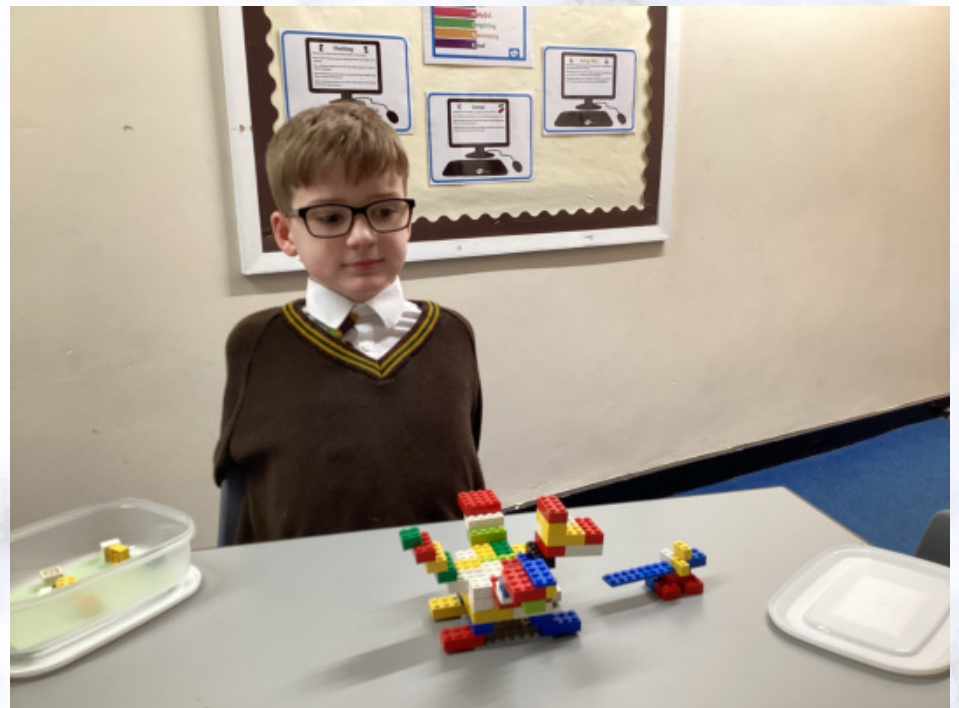
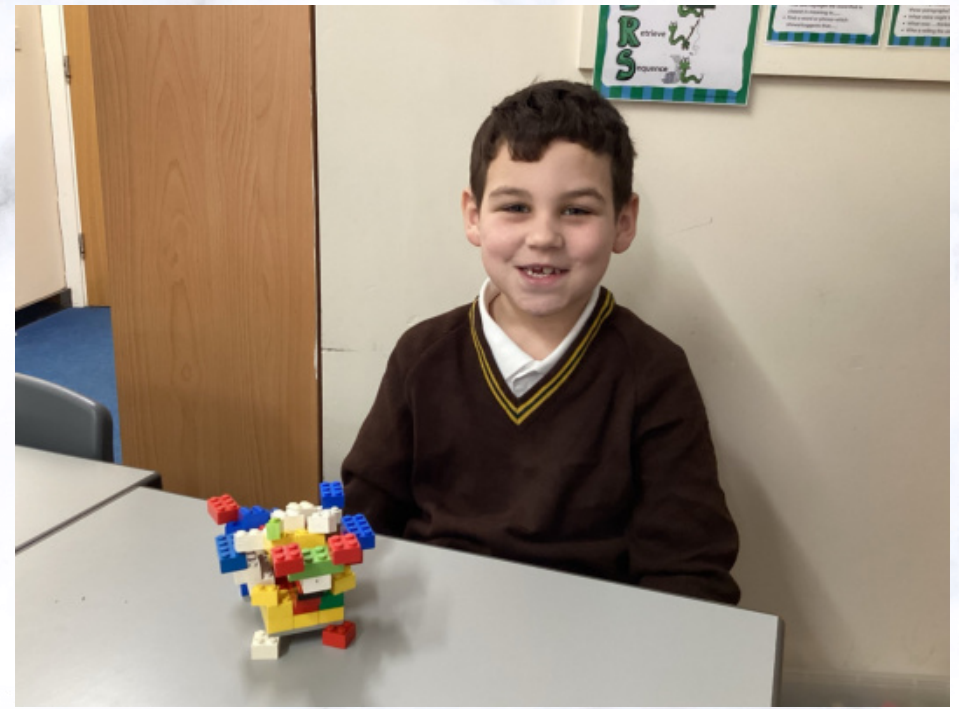
We played a new Lego game.

"I made a house and a fence to put around it."

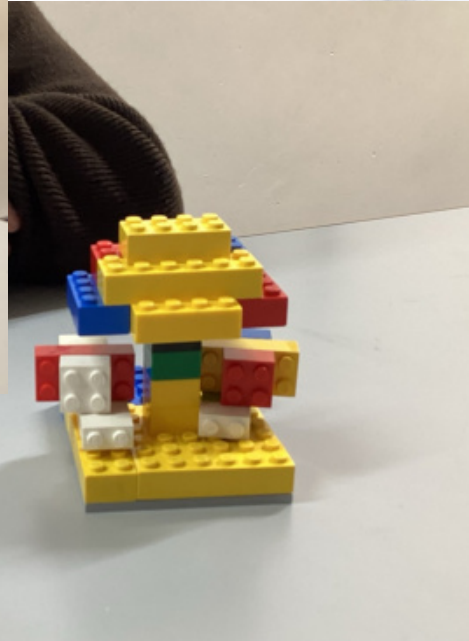

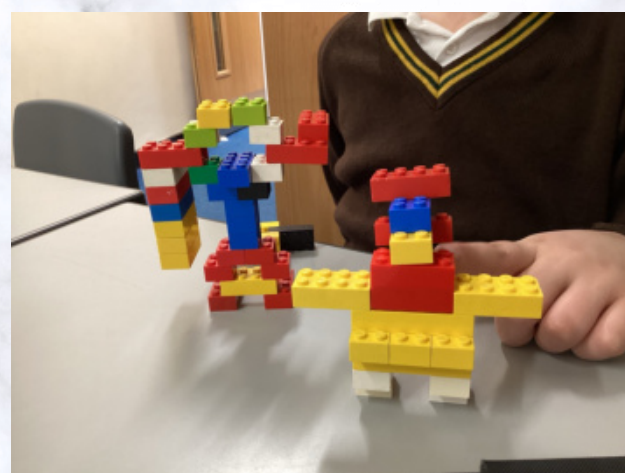
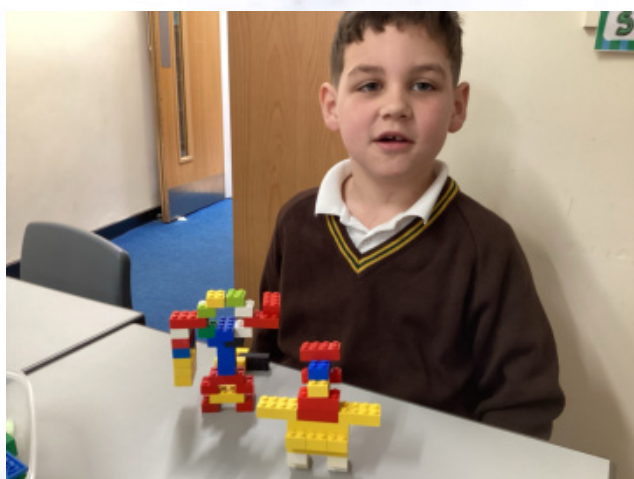
"I made a beach ball, sandcastle, a small beach ball and a spade."

"I've made my chicken Bruce who chased me whilst I was drinking hot chocolate."

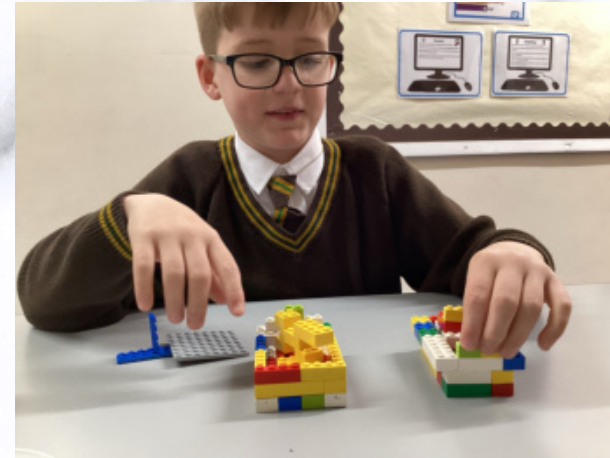


"I've made a scary ride that I went on at Alton Towers."

We talked about the King's Coronation and looked at a photograph of the coronation chair.

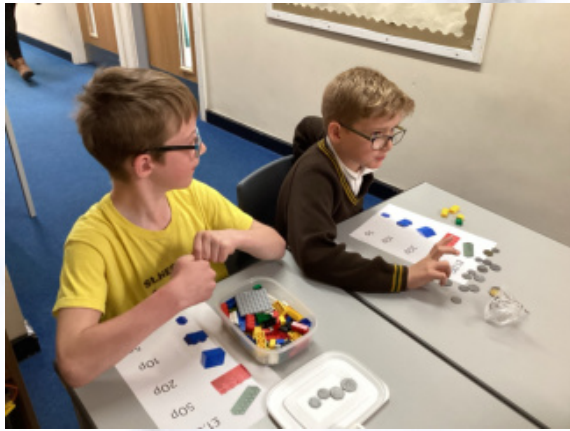


Then we designed and built thrones fit for King Charles III.

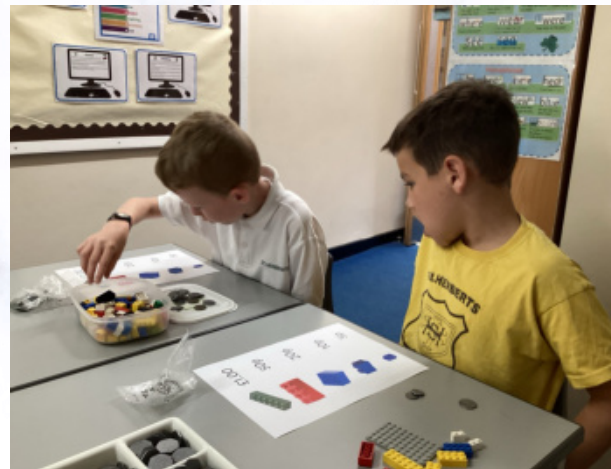


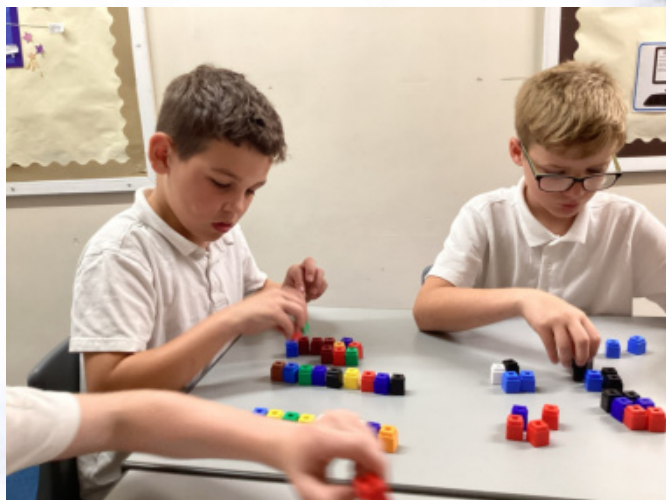

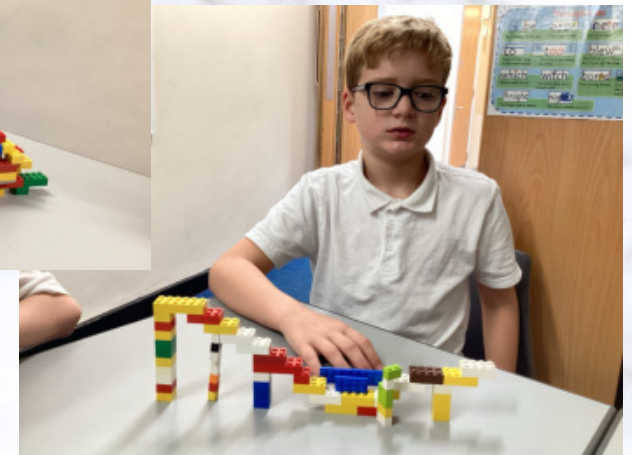
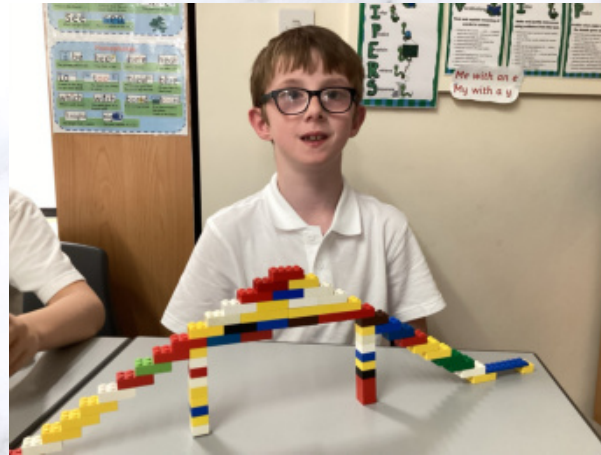


As our topic is London and we have been reading Mary Poppins in class, today we built our versions of famous London buildings.

Lego Challenge: we are trying to build as many different things as we can before the summer holidays start.



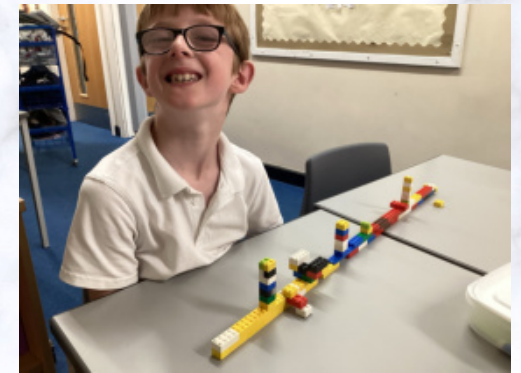
Today we built rollercoasters for an amusement park.

Ford asked us to make the toughest pick up truck in the world.

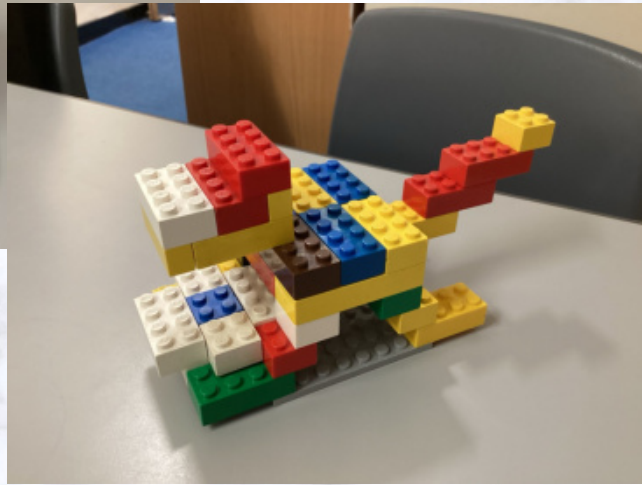
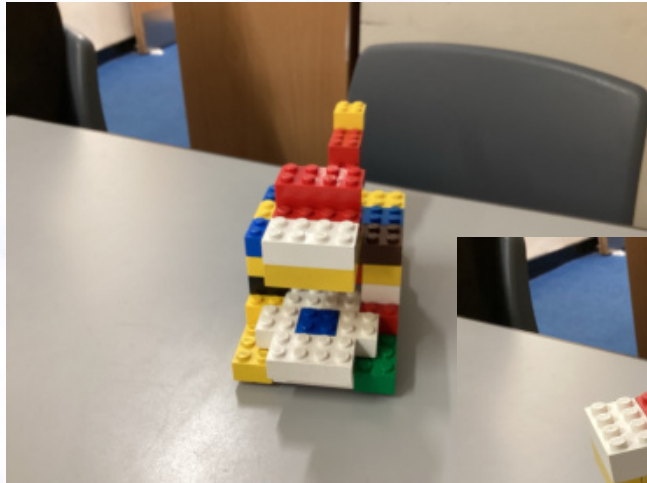


Captain Hook needed a new pirate ship so we started building.



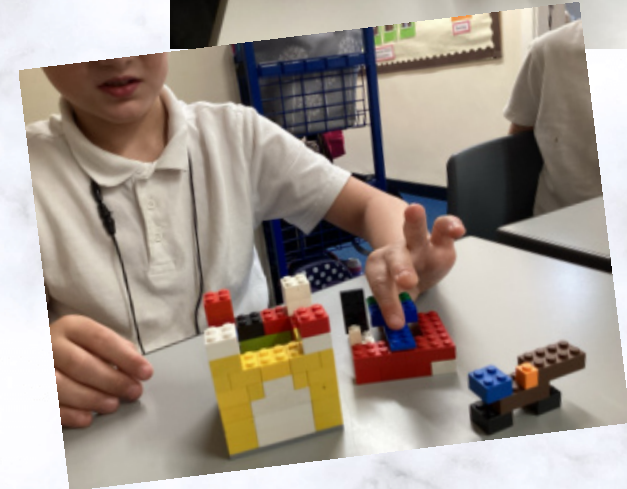
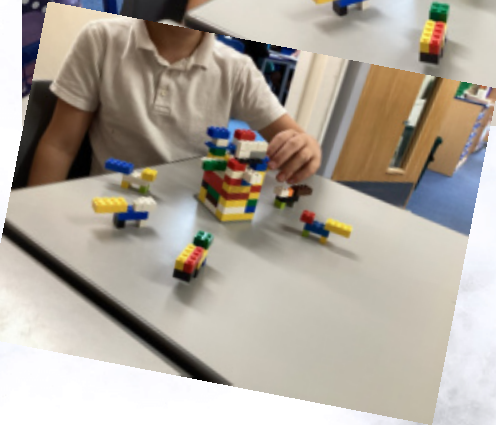
