We created our own designs then told each other what we had made.
































#### Fun Friday














First, we each built an animal and then a pyramid. Then we played a game using the Wheel of Lego Challenges.

A tree






They all looked so different.

We used a template to build these models.

















We practiced our pencil control too.

We then used observational skills to colour the template to match what we had built.





but fun!
















We had fun practising our times tables with Lego.





















We explored lines of symmetry.































We played a memory game.

Our challenge was to make something with 4 legs and 2 wings. It was tricky but look at our creations, we think they are fabulous.




















We built swings, slides, monkey bars, gym equipment and even a zip wire.









"I made fishing rod catching a crab family."

"I built a snake tank and snake."




"I built a giraffe house and a home for a spider."

Then we designed and built thrones fit for King Charles III.














We set up shops, then took turns to be customers or to be shopkeepers.

















Lego Challenge: we are trying to build as many different things as we can before the summer holidays start.

## We built space rockets for NASA...












and then Hollywood hired us to build a set for a Star Wars movie.

ship so we started building.









