LEVEL: ADVANCED BEGINNER

FORMAT: CHARTED ONLY

Download full pattern (including written instructions) on Ravelry

SKILLS REQUIRED:

- Knitting and purling
- Slipping stitches

DIMENSIONS:

65" long x 13.5" wide

YARN:

- 3 skeins of Toil & Trouble Cadence or 620 yards of worsted weight yarn

NEEDLES & NOTIONS:

- US 8 needles (or size needed to obtain gauge)
- Stitch markers
- Tapestry needle

GAUGE:

18 stitches and 26 rows = 4"
Stockinette stitch before blocking

knitting instructions:

Clue #1

Abbreviations and Key:

K = knit

P = purl

RS = Right Side of the work

WS = Wrong Side of the work



RS: Knit

WS: Purl



RS: Purl

WS: Knit



If chart has 12 stitches, repeat 12 times

If chart has 16 stitches, repeat 6 times



RS: Slip purlwise w/ yarn in front

WS: Slip purlwise w/ yarn in back

Finishing: Bind off loosely in pattern. Weave in all yarn ends. Block the finished wrap by soaking completely and pinning out to finished dimensions.
