IDA Sessions 1 and 2 are open to students and recent graduates from all colleges and universities, in any degree program or major. The program fee for IDA 2018 is \$1,750.00 (*Middlebury College students see below*). All logistics and costs between the mainland boat launch on the first day and the mainland boat landing on the last day are covered by the program fee. Participants are responsible for their own transportation to and from Rockland, Maine at the start and end of the program.

Middlebury College applicants: Your institution covers \$1,000 of your program fee and you are responsible for the remaining \$750. Limited financial aid is also available. If admitted, you will be expected to participate in fundraising or some other service activity to help support and sustain the program. To apply for financial aid, please append a statement/explanation of need to this application.

Students from other schools are encouraged to inquire with their home institutions about possible funding assistance. Past participants have secured arts grants, internship funding, and other forms of financial aid.

Applicants should be aware that IDA takes place on a rugged, remote island with no utilities or emergency services. Participants will need to disclose any allergies or special dietary requirements, and sign a *Release and Indemnity Agreement*, before the program begins.
