This morning from 9 to 9:30 a.m. Pamela Kuhn and Sylvia Mims on their WGCH radio show "The Artists' Space" will interview local explorer and filmmaker Luc Hardy about his Antarctic film, "The Pursuit of Endurance -On the Shoulders of Shackleton." The documentary film is due to make its debut on March 27 at 2 p.m at the Focus on French Cinema Festival at the Bow Tie Cinema. The film will be repeated on March 29 at 12:30 p.m.

The film synopsis: 100 years after the epic British Endurance expedition, nine international adventurers, including Luc Hardy, follow in the footsteps of the explorer Ernest Shackleton, hero of one of the greatest survival stories of Antarctic exploration. Their goal: relive part of the epic voyage of the 1914 team, but also live a personal adventure. 800 miles between Elephant Island and South Georgia in sailing boat, ski and pulka. Their gathering of information, oceanographic and scientific data will provide for a better understanding of this part of the world.
