Consider your impact, think of solutions

What are some current issues impacting our ocean and ocean species?

(i.e. ocean acidification, over fishing, plastic, pollution)

Is it being addressed? By who? How? Make of list of who is doing what, locally, provincially, federally, globally (think of stewardship centres, legislation)

What are your ideas about it? What are your solutions? What do we need to do? How do you help? Ready to get involved? What will you commit to doing in your life?

Understand your connection to ocean

Do you live close to it? Have you visited it? Do you eat from it? Do you play in it? Where does the oxygen you're breathing come from? How does the ocean affect climate/ weather? Tell us your story

Understand your impact on oceans, and what this means. Locally, and internationally

How do you rely on the ocean? How do others rely on the ocean? How do you connect with other people who live by the ocean? Are there places that are impacted more than you by climate change? How? Is this fair? Why or why not?

Measure your ocean footprint: Trace your product

Choose any product you have (i.e. phone, tablet, tshirt, school book, basketball, car)

Trace back where it comes from, what it is made of. Try and make a comprehensive list of the impact on our oceans at every stage. How does it impact you, other people, and other species. Why does this matter? What can you do?
