what we do

For over 10 years, Justice Speaks has remained committed to tackling human trafficking through prevention, outreach, collaboration, and restoration in each of our locations — Los Angeles, Thailand, and Nepal. Beyond our outreach to women and children in the sex industry, we lead educational and prevention programs. From developing change-agents in middle schools and colleges here in the U.S. to elementary school camps, scholarship programs, and restoration centers that reach children who are targeted for Thailand and Nepal's sex trade, Justice Speaks is uniquely shifting the culture to prevent sex slavery in women and children as well as restoring those being rescued.

We have seen that through education, women and children can be spared from entering into the sex trade and the debilitating trauma that comes with working in this industry. Our prevention efforts extend even further into culture by partnering with local businesses as well as screenwriters to help champion film content to combat sex modern day slavery.
