### **Children's Activities for the 5778 High Holidays**

All children of all ages are welcome to attend our services in the sanctuary with their parents. For children staying in the main service with their families, breaks can be taken in the library, which has audio streaming of the service and a bucket of toys, books and art supplies.

In addition, the following options are available for your children on both **Rosh Hashanah, Thursday, September 21 and Yom Kippur, Saturday, September 30.**

*These programs are intended for the children to participate in without their parents so that parents can attend the main services in the sanctuary.*

#### **• High Holiday Young Children's Activities & Childcare (2 years old – 6 years old)**

9:45 AM – end of services (~ 12:45 PM)

Drop your child off in the TBT Religious School after 9:30 AM.

Your young child will be taken care of by a group of SALTY teens under the supervision of Kate Rothstein, our High Holiday Children's Activities Coordinator. Children will hear holiday stories, participate in crafts and games, and eat a snack. Please pick your child up in the RS at the end of services.

***An RSVP is required for this program.*** Please RSVP via your High Holiday Form or call the TBT office at 203-245-7028. Please let us know if your child has allergies.

#### **• High Holiday Children's Services and Activities (Kindergarten – Grade 2)**

All Kindergarten through Grade 2 children begin the morning in the main sanctuary with their parents; children go downstairs for their program when excused by the Rabbi. Our SALTY teens will meet the children in the hall by the sanctuary to direct them to a downstairs Religious School classroom. The group will be divided into Grades K & 1 and Grade 2. SALTY leads this program under the supervision of Kate Rothstein, our High Holiday Children's Activities Coordinator.

There will be a brief service oriented to this age group followed by holiday activities and a snack. The children will be dismissed to their parents in the TBT front hall at the end of services in the sanctuary.

#### **• High Holiday Youth Services (Grades 3 - 5)**

All students in grades 3 – 5 will begin the morning in the main sanctuary with their parents; students go to the upstairs classroom for their service when excused by the Rabbi. Our SALTY teens will meet the children in the hall by the sanctuary to direct them to the classroom. Dr. Jason Gaines leads this program. Dr. Gaines, with the assistance of SALTY, leads a holiday service which is age appropriate for our students. After their service, there will be holiday activities and a snack. The students will be dismissed to their parents in the TBT front hall at the end of services in the sanctuary.
