
### Welcome to the Library


- BIG IDEA: I can always go to Jesus!

#### Read the Word



September 6th

"I can always go to Jesus."

- Read: Matthew 16:13-20
- Discuss: How would you answer the question, "who is Jesus?" Why does that question matter?



September 20th

"I can always go to Jesus to show me how to live."


- Read: John 8:12; 9:1-38
  - Discuss: How is living without God like living in the dark?



September 13th

"I can always go to Jesus because he provides for me."

- Read: John 6:1-13, 35
- Discuss: When was a time you saw Jesus provide just what you needed?



September 27th


"I can always go to Jesus to experience God's goodness."

- Read: John 5:1-9; 10:7-10
- Discuss: How did the man in the story expect Jesus to help him? What did Jesus do instead?



October 4th
"I can always go to Jesus when I'm afraid."

- Read: Matthew 14:22-33; John 10:14-15
- Discuss: When has something scared you? What can you do when you feel afraid?




October 18th
"I can always go to Jesus
when I don't know what to do."

- Read: John 4:43-54; 14:6
- Discuss: The man in the story had to choose whether or not to believe Jesus' promise. When have you chosen to trust God's Word?



October 11th
"I can always go to Jesus to help me grow."

- Read: John 15:1-5;Galatians 5:22-23
- Discuss: What are ways we can stay close and connected to Jesus?



October 25th
"I can always go to Jesus when I need hope."

- Read: John 11:1-44
- Discuss: Why do you think Jesus cried with Mary and Martha, even though he knew Lazarus was going to come back to life? What does that tell you about Jesus?

## Go Deeper

Give the Bible story a closer look with these silly book report ideas:

- Write the story in your own words, then replace a few words with blanks to create goofy Mad Libs to share with your family!
- Act out the story. You could use toys, create your own puppets, or put together creative costumes from what you find around your house.
- Illustrate the story and make your own picture book.
- Turn the story into a comic strip, complete with sound effects and speech bubbles.
- O Create a pretend instagram post from the perspective of someone in the story.
- Read the story in a children's Bible, or in a different version. What's the same? What differences can you spot?
