2. Family Requirements and Information

[Please read]

1. Camp programming is developed and delivered by qualified instructors through the Ontario Sailing Association's Boom Mobile Sailing School. www.ontariosailing.ca. Boats (Boats- TBC) are provided by the Boom Program.
2. The BOOM Mobile program is intended to give participants a fun introduction to the sport of sailing, and give them an opportunity to develop their sailing skills. Participants are taught the basics of sailing using the Canadian Yachting Association's (CYA) By using double-handed sailing dinghies the CYA can introduce beginners to sailing, while still challenging the more advanced sailor.
3. Registration will be taken in the following priority: 1) Returning Sailors and siblings who are in the process of completing their levels, 2) Open Registration, 3) Past Sailors who have completed all 3 levels. Places will be assigned on first come first served basis and a waiting list will be formed.

4. Enrollment is limited to 16 children for the daytime lessons. Minimum numbers are required to run each week. Ages 8-14 (children's program)
5. Sailing Registration form must accompany payment (**no exceptions**)
6. Parents and guardians are welcomed and encouraged to stay during programs and assist whenever possible particularly with unloading boats/equipment at the start and end of sessions. For safety reasons, at least one parent volunteer is required to be on the island each day of lessons.
7. All classes take place from Cow Island, BRLA's water access property on the Big Rideau Lake. There is no electricity or drinking water on Cow Island. Children must bring their own drinks, snacks and lunch.
8. Course costs will only be refunded if another participant is found to take the place.

Note: Boats and supplies will be unloaded on the day prior to the sailing lessons. Parents are kindly asked to assist with the transfer of boats + supplies to Cow Island in order for everything to arrive safely before dusk. Instructors are billeted on the lake by BRLA volunteers.

At the end of the week, boats and supplies will either be sailed or towed (weather dependant) back to the loading area on the last day of sailing lessons.
