BISHOP'S LODGE IN SANTA FE, NM, CLOSURES FOR RENOVATION AND EXPANSION

Stable Facilities to Remain Open

HRV Hotel Partners, an Atlanta-based hotel developer, announced today that as of October 2, 2015, Bishop's Lodge in Santa Fe, New Mexico's Tesuque Valley, will close for renovation and expansion. It was also announced that the horse stables, which offer trail rides, will remain in operation during the construction process, and will be accessible via Bauer Road.

According to Richard Holland, managing partner with HRV Hotel Partners, the historic and iconic 1920s ranch resort is preparing for a major renovation and expansion, which will begin this year and be completed in late spring 2017. The renovation will include the demolition and remodeling of the existing rooms and public areas at the property, as well as new construction to expand the hotel to 123 rooms and suites.
