Artists with accepted work must submit an image file (jpeg) of each piece for our online Harrah's Gallery store. All work MUST be wired for hanging – NO EXCEPTIONS. Each piece MUST be labeled on back with Title, Medium, Price, Size & Artist Name. WORK NOT PROPERLY WIRED OR LABELED WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR JUDGING.

We will take special care to ensure the safety of the art but will not be responsible for loss or damage. You are encouraged to self insure your work.

Harrah's will have final say in the selection of work to be hung. A jurying and hanging fee of \$25.00, check made out to **Art on Avenue of the States**, should accompany your registration. If your work is not chosen, the hanging fee (\$20.00) will be refunded. If you are a Member of the gallery, your hanging fee is \$15.00 and the total fee is \$20.

A 30% commission on all sold work will be taken by **Art on Avenue of the States**. Work will stay on display for up to six months. If a piece is sold, you may have the opportunity to replace it with a work of similar size.

Works that are not accepted for this exhibition, due to space limitations, will be eligible for re-submission in the next show. Work previously seen by the juror will not need to be re-juried. A \$20.00 hanging fee will be charged at that time.
