- Whereas:** Miami Students already carry their MiamiID which they use for everything from buying food to renting books from the library.
- Whereas:** Other universities such as George Washington University already provide students with emergency numbers on the back of their IDs, giving students easier access to vital campus resources at all times.
- Therefore be it resolved:** The Associated Student Government formally requests that the MiamiID be reworked to include emergency and non-emergency numbers on the back of the card to give students easier access to the vital resources Miami and Oxford already provide.
- Further it be resolved:** These numbers should include, but not be limited to, the numbers for the Miami and Oxford police departments, student health services, student counseling services, and the Butler County sexual assault response coordinator.
