<p>Registered Nurse Obstetrics Full-time - Nights</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California R.N. license. Six months recent experience in perinatal nursing preferred. BLS and successful completion of neonatal resuscitation within six months of employment.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: The staff nurse in Obstetrics functions independently in performing the nursing process through assessment, planning, implementation and evaluation of safe therapeutic care for all patients during labor, deliver, immediate port-partum and newborn care; including those patients in complex situations with overt and covert needs and/or complications of treatment during his/her shift. The staff nurse manages and coordinates the clinical activities on the patient unit during his/her shift.</p>
<p>Registered Nurse First Assistant or Physician Assistant Surgery Full-time or Part-time Benefited</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California RN License or current California Physician Assistant License. Successfully completed an approved RNFA course of instruction and met the proctoring criteria. Minimum two (2) years perioperative experience. ACLS required.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: The RNFA renders direct patient care as part of the perioperative team by functioning as a first assistant under the supervision of a surgeon with active privileges at Fairchild Medical Center.</p>
<p>Registered Physical Therapist Rehabilitation Therapy Full-time</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Licensed as a Registered Physical Therapist with the State of California. New graduate or more experience required, depending on department need. CPR Preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: Responsible for organizing, conducting and developing a medically prescribed program of physical therapy in both hospital and out-patient setting.</p>
<p>Clinical Laboratory Scientist Laboratory Full-time</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California Clinical Laboratory Technologist License. Twelve months as a trainee required; one to three years of experience desirable.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: Performs all laboratory tests necessary for diagnosis and treatment of patients at the request of attending physician(s). Responsible for reporting results which are accurate as substantiated by the use of appropriate controls. Performs and demonstrates proficiency and understanding of routine procedures for all areas of the clinical laboratory with minimal supervision.</p>
<p>Registered Nurse Emergency Department Full Time/Per Diem</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California R.N. License required. BLS and ACLS certification required with six (6) months. Minimum of one (1) year acute care experience within the past two(2) years preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: The staff nurse in the Emergency Department functions independently in performing the nursing process through assessment, planning, intervention and evaluation of safe therapeutic care for all patient's overt and covert needs and/or complications of treatment in the Emergency Department. Manages and coordinates the clinical activities in the department during his/her shift.</p>
<p>Registered Nurse Intensive Care Unit Full Time/Per Diem</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California R.N. License. BLS and ACLS certification required within six (6) months. Minimum of one (1) year critical care experience within the last three (3) years required. Satisfactory completion of a course in critical care, intensive care or coronary care within the last three (3) years preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: Function independently in performing the nursing process through assessment, planning, intervention and evaluation of safe therapeutic care for all patient's overt and covert needs and/or complications of treatment on his/her shift. The staff nurse manages and coordinates the clinical activities on the patient unit during his/her shift.</p>
<p>Registered Nurse Med/Surg Full Time</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California RN License and BLS required. Minimum of one (1) year acute care experience within the past three (3) years preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: The staff nurse in the Med/Surg Unit functions independently in performing the nursing process through assessment, planning, intervention and evaluation of safe therapeutic care for all patient's overt and covert needs and/or complications of treatment on his/her shift. The staff nurse manages and coordinates the clinical activities on their patient assignment and may be assigned to coordinate the unit activities during his/her shift.</p>
<p>Licensed Vocational Nurse FMC Clinic Full Time</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California L.V.N. License required. Two (2) years' experience of nursing in a doctor's office preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: Administers nursing care to designated patients under the supervision of a F.N.P., P.A., or Physician. Performs a variety of direct and indirect patient care duties/activities.</p>
<p>Charge Nurse ICU Per Diem</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California R.N. License. BLS and ACLS certification required within six (6) months. Minimum of one (1) year critical care experience within the last three (3) years required. Satisfactory completion of a course in critical care, intensive care or coronary care within the last three (3) years preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: Function independently in performing the nursing process through assessment, planning, intervention and evaluation of safe therapeutic care for all patient's overt and covert needs and/or</p>

Manages and coordinates the clinical activities in the department during his/her shift.</p>
<p>Registered Nurse Surgery Part Time, Benefited</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California R.N. License required. BLS & ACLS required within six (6) months. One (1) recent year Operating Room experience preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: The staff nurse in the Operating Room functions independently in performing the nursing process through assessment, planning, intervention and evaluation of safe therapeutic care for all patient's overt and covert needs and/or complications of treatment on his/her shift. The staff nurse manages and coordinates the clinical activities on their patient assignment and may be assigned to coordinate the unit activities during his/her shift.</p>
<p>Receptionist/Clerk FMC Clinic Part Time, Non Benefited</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: High School Education or GED equivalent required. Some computer experience preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: Responsible for scheduling, answering phones, filing, maintenance of medical records and registering patients.</p>
<p>Phlebotomist Laboratory Per Diem</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: American Society of Phlebotomy Technicians certificate required. High School Education or GED equivalent required.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: Perform venipunctures to collect blood specimens. Perform laboratory tests in compliance with the law. Perform daily recordings of temperatures and Blood Bank inventory. Perform other duties requested by chief Technologist.</p>
