<p>Registered Nurse Obstetrics Full-time - Nights</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California R.N. license. Six months recent experience in perinatal nursing preferred. BLS and successful completion of neonatal resuscitation within six months of employment.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: The staff nurse in Obstetrics functions independently in performing the nursing process through assessment, planning, implementation and evaluation of safe therapeutic care for all patients during labor, deliver, immediate post-partum and newborn care; including those patients in complex situations with overt and covert needs and/or complications of treatment during his/her shift. The staff nurse manages and coordinates the clinical activities on the patient unit during his/her shift.</p>
<p>Registered Nurse First Assistant or Physician Assistant Surgery Full-time or Part-time Benefited</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California RN License or current California Physician Assistant License. Successfully completed an approved RNFA course of instruction and met the proctoring criteria. Minimum two (2) years perioperative experience. ACLS required.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: The RNFA renders direct patient care as part of the perioperative team by functioning as a first assistant under the supervision of a surgeon with active privileges at Fairchild Medical Center.</p>
<p>Registered Nurse Emergency Department Full Time/Per Diem</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California R.N. License required. BLS and ACLS certification required with six (6) months. Minimum of one (1) year acute care experience within the past two(2) years preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: The staff nurse in the Emergency Department functions independently in performing the nursing process through assessment, planning, intervention and evaluation of safe therapeutic care for all patient's overt and covert needs and/or complications of treatment in the Emergency Department. Manages and coordinates the clinical activities in the department during his/her shift.</p>
<p>Registered Nurse Intensive Care Unit Full Time/Per Diem</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California R.N. License. BLS and ACLS certification required within six (6) months. Minimum of one (1) year critical care experience within the last three (3) years required. Satisfactory completion of a course in critical care, intensive care or coronary care within the last three (3) years preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: Function independently in performing the nursing process through assessment, planning, intervention and evaluation of safe therapeutic care for all patient's overt and covert needs and/or complications of treatment on his/her shift. The staff nurse manages and coordinates the clinical activities on the patient unit during his/her shift.</p>
<p>Registered Nurse Med/Surg Full Time</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California RN License and BLS required. Minimum of one (1) year acute care experience within the past three (3) years preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: The staff nurse in the Med/Surg Unit functions independently in performing the nursing process through assessment, planning, intervention and evaluation of safe therapeutic care for all patient's overt and covert needs and/or complications of treatment on his/her shift. The staff nurse manages and coordinates the clinical activities on their patient assignment and may be assigned to coordinate the unit activities during his/her shift.</p>
<p>Registered Nurse Surgery Part Time, Benefited</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California R.N. License required. BLS & ACLS required within six (6) months. One (1) recent year Operating Room experience preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: The staff nurse in the Operating Room functions independently in performing the nursing process through assessment, planning, intervention and evaluation of safe therapeutic care for all patient's overt and covert needs and/or complications of treatment on his/her shift. The staff nurse manages and coordinates the clinical activities on their patient assignment and may be assigned to coordinate the unit activities during his/her shift.</p>
<p>Health Information Manager Health Information Full Time</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Bachelor's Degree in Health Information and RHIA required. Minimum of five years in Health Information Management experience, and minimum of three years managerial experience required. Experience with Electronic Medical Records (EMR) and IT functionality experience. Excellent verbal and written communication skills required. Experience with continuous performance improvement preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: The Health Information Manager coordinates and monitors the performance of the HIM operations, including scanning into the electronic record, analysis/coding, completion, transcription, filing, storage and release of patient medical information. Performs QA and monitors performance metrics. Prepares routine/periodic statistical reports using 3M software and MS Excel. Establishes and maintains policies and procedures to meet standards of The Joint commission and California laws as required. Participates in many committee activities inclusive of leading/teaching/training staff both within/outside the department.</p>

Medical Technologist Laboratory Full Time	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California Department of Health Services Clinic Laboratory Scientist license required. One (1) to three (3) years of CLS experience preferred. Expanded knowledge and interest in one or more laboratory departments is preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: Performs all Laboratory test necessary for the diagnosis and treatment of patients at the request of the attending physician(s). Responsible for reporting accurate results substantiated by the use of appropriate controls. Demonstrates proficiency and understanding of routine procedures for all areas of the clinical laboratory with minimal supervision.</p>
Shift Supervisor Nursing Administration Per Diem	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California RN License required. BLS, ACLS required within six (6) months. Recent Supervisory experience preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: The shift supervisor coordinates the delivery of patient care for all nursing departments in the hospital. They are responsible for providing adequate staffing, within the budgeted FTE's to the various nursing departments. They act as a resource and provide direction to all nursing staff.</p>
Sterile Processing Tech Central Supply Part Time, Non-Benefited	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: High School diploma/GED equivalent required. Ability to write legibly, spell correctly, and perform basic mathematics required. Knowledge of medical terminology preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: The sterile Processing Technician is responsible for sterilization and provision of medical supplies and equipment to various departments in the hospital.</p>
Radiology Tech Diagnostic Imaging Full Time	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Completion of AMA approved program in Radiologic Technology. State of California and ARRT registration and certification. Two (2) years experience as a Radiologic Technologist preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: Performs radiographic procedures at a technical level not requiring constant supervision of technical detail; performs a variety of technical procedures that require independent judgment, and use of ingenuity and initiative to apply prescribed ionizing radiation for radiologic diagnosis. May be required to rotate standby and call back hours.</p>
Licensed Vocational Nurse FMC Clinic Full Time	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California LVN license required. Two (2) years of nursing in a doctor's office preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: Administers nursing care to designated patients under the supervision of a F.N.P., P.A., or Physician. Performs a variety of direct and indirect patient care duties/activities.</p>
